A MESSAGE FROM FR. STEVE

Rejoice!

This, the fourth Sunday of Lent, is called by that name because of the beginning of the opening antiphon for today's Mass: "Laetare Jerusalem," which is translated, "Rejoice, Jerusalem!" And we do rejoice. We are at the midway point of this season of penance, looking forward to the celebration of the holiest week of the Christian year. Just as we do the third Sunday of Advent (Gaudete Sunday), today the priest wears "Rose" vestments. Let us, indeed, be joyful that we are sons and daughters of God through our baptism.

Lumen Veritatis is this Thursday (3/15)

Because we expect there to be a large audience for Fr. Jacques Phillipe's talk, entitled, "How to Find and Communicate Peace," we have decided that the talk will begin at 7:00 p.m. in the church. After the talk, everyone will be invited to Mercy Hall for refreshments and fellowship. I hope you can join us for this presentation by one of the Spiritual Masters of our time. 
