A MESSAGE FROM FR. STEVE

Family Healing Mass

This Saturday morning, March 24, from 10-12:30, you are invited to join us for an audio talk by Dr. Bob Schuchts about the power of the sacraments for healing. There will be time after the talk for everyone to reflect on the generational effects of sin in their own families, and then to celebrate a Mass for the healing of families. (Please note that this will not be a Mass for the Anointing of the Sick.) We will be listening to the talk in the church, then spend twenty minutes or so for prayerful reflection, and then pray the Mass together. Call Liz, Sean, or Fr. Steve for more information.

Family Evening of Irish Dancing (Potluck)

This Saturday evening (March 24), you, your family, and friends are invited to come to a Ceili Dance and potluck in Mercy Hall (127 Rumsey). Enjoy a mini-show performed by McCartney Dancers, learn a jig, and join in Ceili dances. Bring a dish/snack to share and wear comfortable clothes. This will be after the 5:00 p.m. (6-9 p.m.) This is a free event for the whole family. It promises to be a great time.

Holiest of Weeks . . .

Today, we recall Christ's triumphal entry into Jerusalem. We honor Jesus too, waiving our own palms of victorious celebration, with the poignant awareness of what Jesus came to Jerusalem to do for us—die! And then, Praised be Jesus Christ, rise again. This entire week is one long meditation on love and discipleship. Give yourself, your family, your friends a great gift and join us as often as possible. Holy Week is a great gift to us, and we are exceedingly blessed as we spend time in prayer and gratitude this week.

Sacred Triduum

This Thursday, we again begin the "Sacred Triduum," or the Holy Three Days. Note that there are no Masses Thursday, Friday, or Saturday mornings, because the Sacred Triduum forms a great liturgical whole. During the day on Thursday, my brother priests and I will gather with the bishop in Lansing for the blessing of the Holy Oils and for the renewal of our priestly vows. In the evening, we will celebrate the institution of the Eucharist and priesthood at the Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7:00 p.m.

Eucharistic Procession to the Altar of Repose

After communion, Holy Thursday evening, we will process with the Blessed Sacrament to the Altar of Repose, which will be in the parish hall, where the faithful are invited to spend time with Jesus (ending at Midnight). Note that adoration will be available Friday morning from 8:00 a.m. until 11:30am at the Altar of Repose (again, in the parish hall).

Good Friday of the Lord's Passion

On Friday, there will be many opportunities to pray together. The Church's liturgy of the Lord's Passion will be held at 12:10 p.m. That day, for the second time in a week, we will recall together the Passion of Our Lord Jesus Christ. We will also pray for our needs and the needs of the world, in the context of Christ's love poured out. We will then venerate the wood of the cross and receive communion. At 3:00 p.m., we will gather again to pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet at the "hour of mercy." Finally, in the evening, we will pray the Stations of the Cross at 6:30 p.m. As part of the needs of the world, Pope Francis has asked that we support the Christians in the Holy Land. We will have a collection on Good Friday, to support the Catholic schools and other religious education supported by the Pontifical Good Friday Collection. Holy Saturday Night: The Easter Vigil

We spend the day on Holy Saturday in quiet silence and prayer on Saturday as we recall Christ lying in the tomb for us. That evening, we celebrate the Easter Vigil, which is the greatest Solemnity of the liturgical year. We will gather outside at dark, and begin the Solemn Vigil at 8:30 p.m. We will begin with the lighting of the fire that represents Christ's triumph over death, and then process into the church, following the Paschal Candle. Christ is our Light, and we are enlightened by Him. If you have not attended an Easter Vigil, plan to come. It is a glorious celebration of the love of God and the power of Christ (and those baptized into Christ) over death. Come, let us worship!

Easter Sunday: The Resurrection of the Lord




