

The Divine Mercy Chaplet will be prayed followed by the opportunity to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Those who were present at the Easter Vigil had the tremendous privilege of witnessing four who were newly baptized and five others who entered the Catholic Church, and two more who completed their sacraments of initiation by being confirmed. The Peace of Forgiveness


