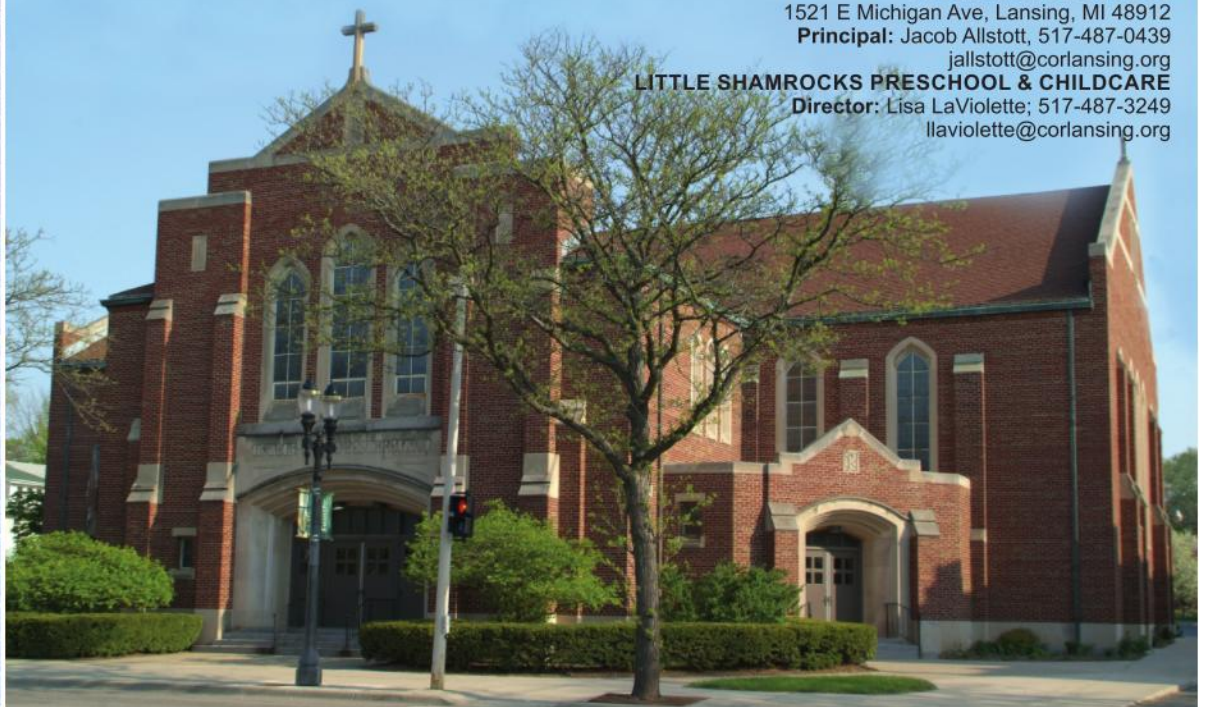

## A MESSAGE FROM FR. STEVE

### Celebrating Our Risen Lord

We conclude the Octave of Easter today with the celebration of Divine Mercy Sunday. Saint John Paul the Great gave us this great Feast Day in response to the Lord's words to St. Faustina. The Lord is merciful! Indeed, *He is mercy*. If you have the time, please consider taking advantage of the grace of the Divine Mercy this (Sunday) afternoon at 2:30 at St. Therese. The Divine Mercy Chaplet will be prayed followed by the opportunity to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

### Great Cause for Rejoicing!

Those who were present at the Easter Vigil had the tremendous privilege of witnessing four who were newly baptized and five others who entered the Catholic Church, and two more who completed their sacraments of initiation by being confirmed. Congratulations to all those who have become part of our Church (and parish) family. Thank you to all of who so effectively spread the good news by word and example, and encouraged these eight brothers and sisters in their journey of faith. Let us continue to pray for them as they grow in their relationship with Jesus.

### Men's Evening of Adoration

The Men's Evening of Adoration will be held Thursday, April 12<sup>th</sup> from 7:00 to 8:00 p.m., concluding with Benediction. It is a great opportunity to spend some time before the Lord, to hear a brief reflection from one of the men, to go to confession, and receive the Lord's blessing in Benediction. Those who gather typically enjoy a time of fellowship afterward in Mercy Hall. Join us if you're able. (The women's evenings are held on the fourth Thursdays of every month.)

### Healing Encounter

We will be having a healing Encounter this coming Saturday, April 14th. *Encounter* is a time of praise, worship, adoration, and prayers for healing. It begins at 7:00 p.m., and we will finish up by 9:00 p.m. Join us for as much of the evening as you can. It is a time of prayer for each other and inviting the Lord to make Himself present in our midst.

### The Peace of Forgiveness

Today in our Gospel, Jesus appears to the Apostles, and says, "Peace be with you." That's His desire for each of us—that we would experience peace that surpasses human understanding. He said "Peace be with you" a second time, and then breathed on them, saying "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them; whose sins you retain are re-

tained." In that special outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the apostles, the Church sees the institution of the Sacrament of Penance. And He gave it to us the very day He rose from the dead—so much did He know our need! As a priest I know the power of the words of absolution; I've felt the impact as a penitent myself, and I've witnessed the freedom of other penitents when they have confessed their sins and received absolution. Divine Mercy is our hope!

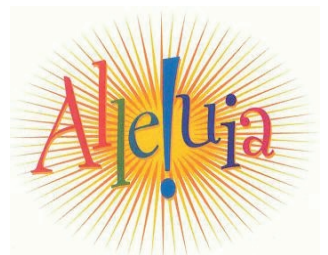


## Thanks...Alleluia is our song!

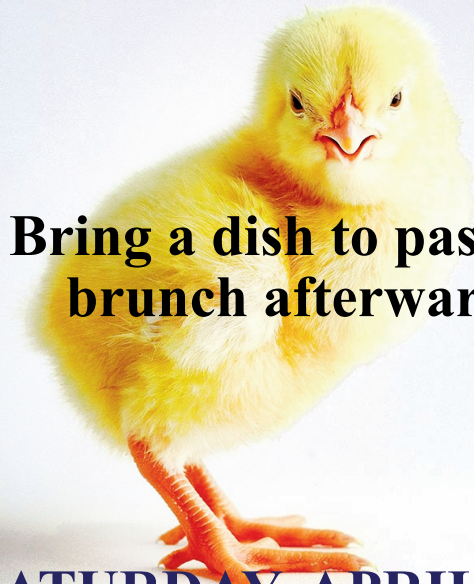
