Blessed John Henry Newman

Last week in my homily, I quoted from some reflections of Blessed John Henry Newman, which highlighted the importance that each and every one of us has in the family of God. Here are some of his "Meditations on Christian Doctrine" from what is annotated to be reflections for March 7 (a link to the entire webpage can be found on our website):

God was all-complete, all-blessed in Himself; but it was His will to create a world for His glory. He is Almighty, and might have done all things Himself, but it has been His will to bring about His purposes by the beings He has created. We are all {301} created to His glory—we are created to do His will. I am created to do something or to be something for which no one else is created; I have a place in God's counsels, in God's world, which no one else has; whether I be rich or poor, despised or esteemed by man, God knows me and calls me by my name.

God has created me to do Him some definite service; He has committed some work to me which He has not committed to another.

I have my mission Somehow I am necessary for His purposes, as necessary in my place as an Archangel in his I have a part in this great work; I am a link in a chain, a bond of connexion between persons. He has not created me for naught. I shall do good, I shall do His work; I shall be an angel of peace, a preacher of truth in my own place . . . if I do but keep His commandments and serve Him in my calling.

Diocesan Services Appeal 2018


