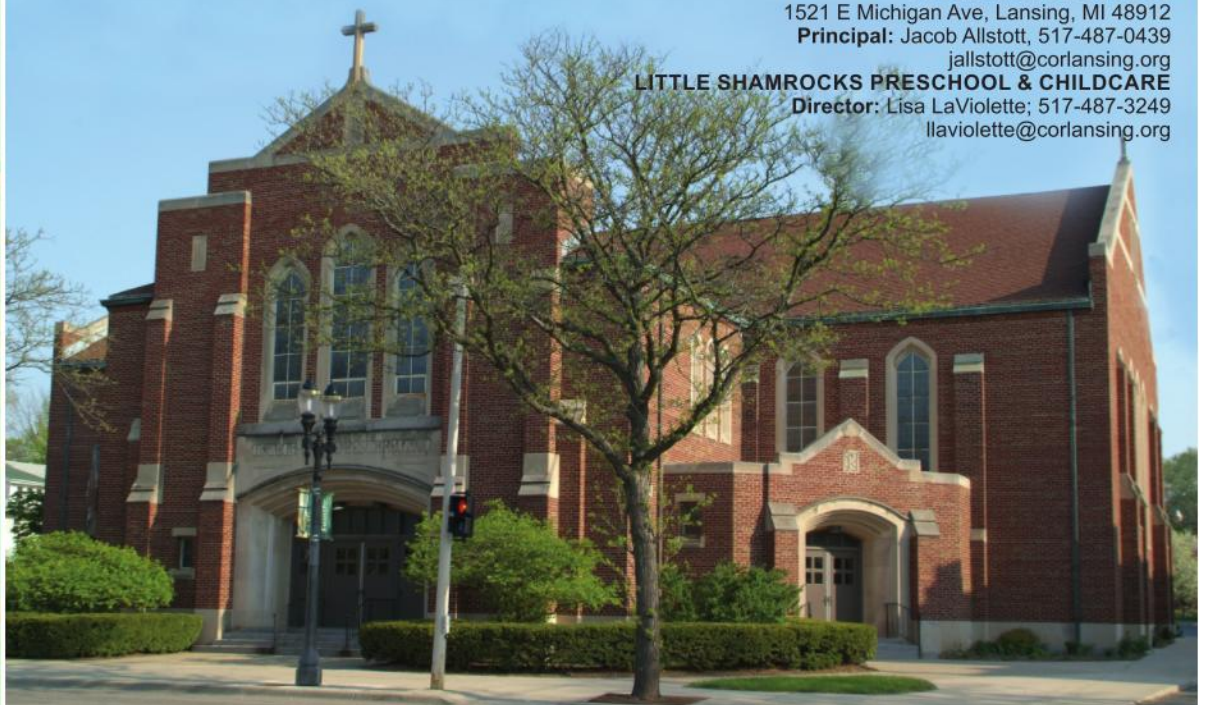

Corpus Christi Procession Next Sunday

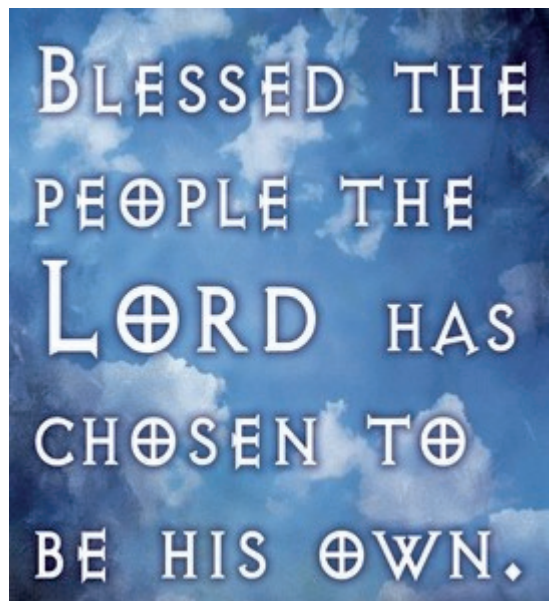

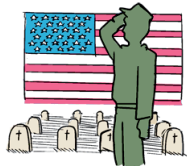

Enrollment Update

We are currently at 130 students registered for next year, and we are estimating an enrollment increase. Our early estimations are indicating an enrollment between 155-165 students. Plus, I have recently been giving 2-3 tours per week, so those numbers may go up. It is possible we will reach a waitlist in KG, 1st, 2nd, 5th, and 8th grade. I know this is a result of Fr. Steve's spiritual leadership over the school, the prayers of our parishioners, and the working of the Holy Spirit in and through our staff. *Please continue pray for next year's enrollment and those whom God is calling to become a part of our Resurrection family.*

Student Growth Reports

The students have recently completed their end of year benchmark tests, and I have started my initial review of the data. I am extremely pleased with the results. The majority of our students met or exceeded national growth projections. *We exceeded our spring-to-spring projections by 130% and fall-to-spring projections by 120%.* This continues to prove for me what St. Paul teaches in 1 Corinthians 3:6. "I (parents) planted, Apollos (teachers) watered, but God caused the growth." I am always in awe and give praise for what the Lord accomplishes with the willing hearts and minds of our students, but I must also extend my deep gratitude to our parents and teachers for their work to make it even possible.

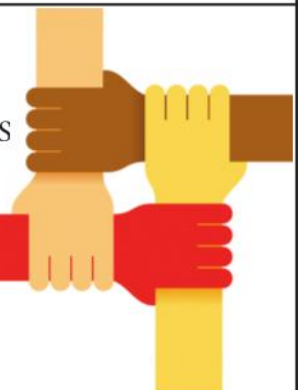
