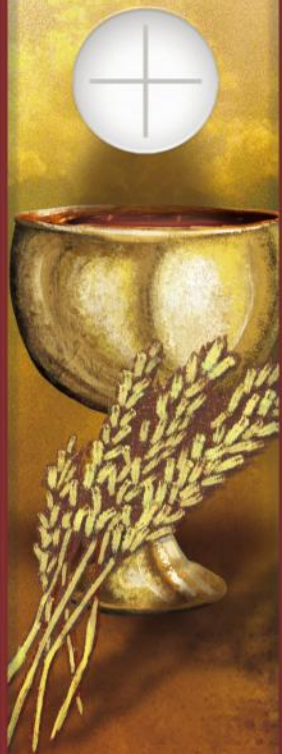

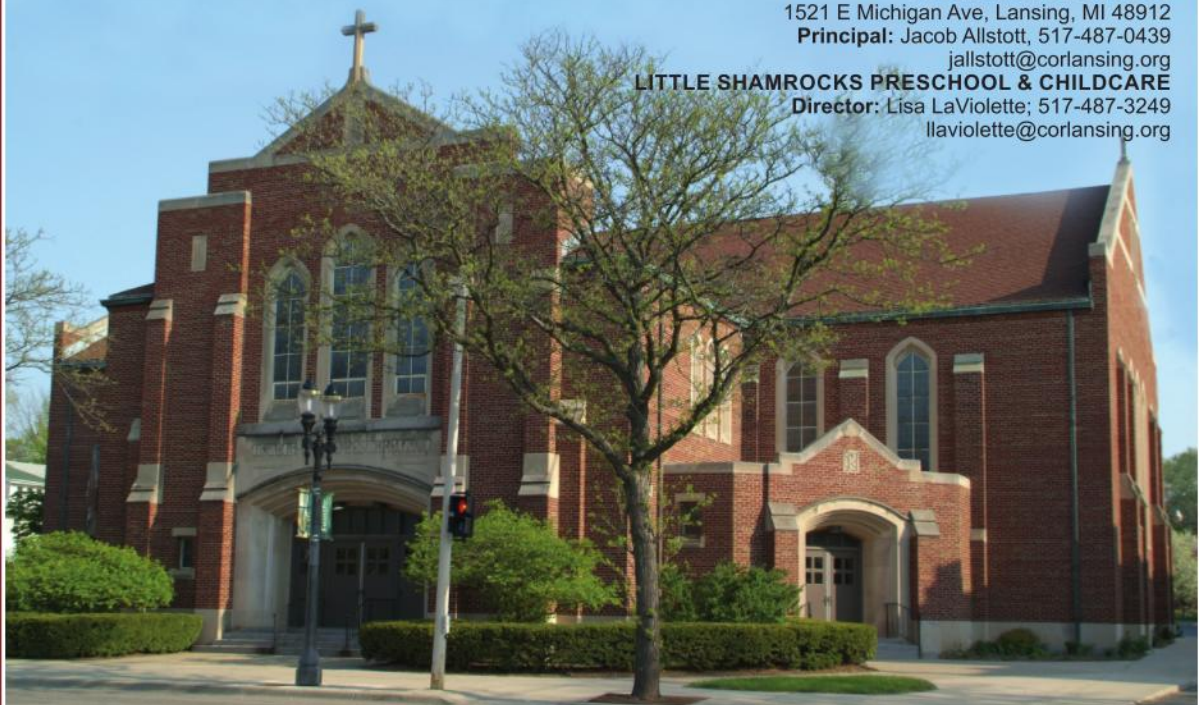
PARISH MISSION STATEMENT:

A MESSAGE FROM FR. STEVE

Come, Holy Spirit!

This Sunday, June 3rd, at St. Mary's Cathedral, Bishop Boyea will be confirming students from Resurrection along with those from other parishes in the diocese. Please pray for the candidates as well as their families and sponsors as they prepare their hearts to receive the abundant graces of Confirmation. May they (and all the baptized) be open to the outpouring of the Holy Spirit.

Come Encounter Jesus

This coming Saturday evening, June 9th, we will have a time of praise, worship, prayer, adoration, and confession from 7:00 to 8:30 p.m. in the church. It's a great opportunity to worship God and to open our hearts to have Him do healing work in us. Come, and bring others with you. Prayer teams will be available to pray for healing and other requests. Come, and invite someone to join you.

Summer Schedules

Beginning this week and running through August 27, which is the first Monday school Mass, there will be no Monday morning confessions or Masses. Nearby, there are several good options for Monday Masses: St. Therese has an 8:30 a.m. Mass, the cathedral has a 12:05 p.m. Mass, and St. John's has a Mass at 12:15 p.m. on Mondays. There are other local Masses as well, which you can find by searching the Mass Times website (masstimes.org). Note also that, for the summer, parish office hours on Fridays will be 9:00 – 12:00 noon. (August 31st, we will return to the normal Friday hours: 9:00-12:00; 1-4:30 p.m.)

Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)

Today, we celebrate this great Solemnity, which announces to the world our devotion to Jesus, truly present in the Blessed Sacrament, Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. Our liturgies owe a tremendous amount to St. Thomas Aquinas, a Dominican priest and Doctor of the Church. He was brilliant and prayerful and he handed on to us the fruits of his contemplation, in true Dominican fashion. St. Thomas had a mystical experience while celebrating mass on December 6, 1273, a few months before his death, after which he stopped writing the *Summa*. Despite the genius and wisdom of his writing, after the glimpse he was given of the beauty and glory in a vision, he said "I cannot go on . . . All that I have written seems to me like so much straw compared to what I have seen and what has been revealed to me." On another occasion, Jesus spoke to him from the crucifix, saying, "You have written well of me, Thomas! What do you desire?" To which, Thomas replied, "*Non nisi te, Domine.*" Only you, Lord (Jesus). May our hearts and minds be like unto St. Thomas Aquinas, that after an offer from the Lord of anything, we would wisely choose "nothing but Jesus." For, having Him, we have ALL.

Speaking of Dominicans, we have been blessed again this year by the presence of four Dominican Sisters of Mary, Mother of the Eucharist. Their service at Resurrection School and Lansing Catholic, and their presence in our parish community, has been a great gift to us and to the children who attend our schools.

Two Hearts

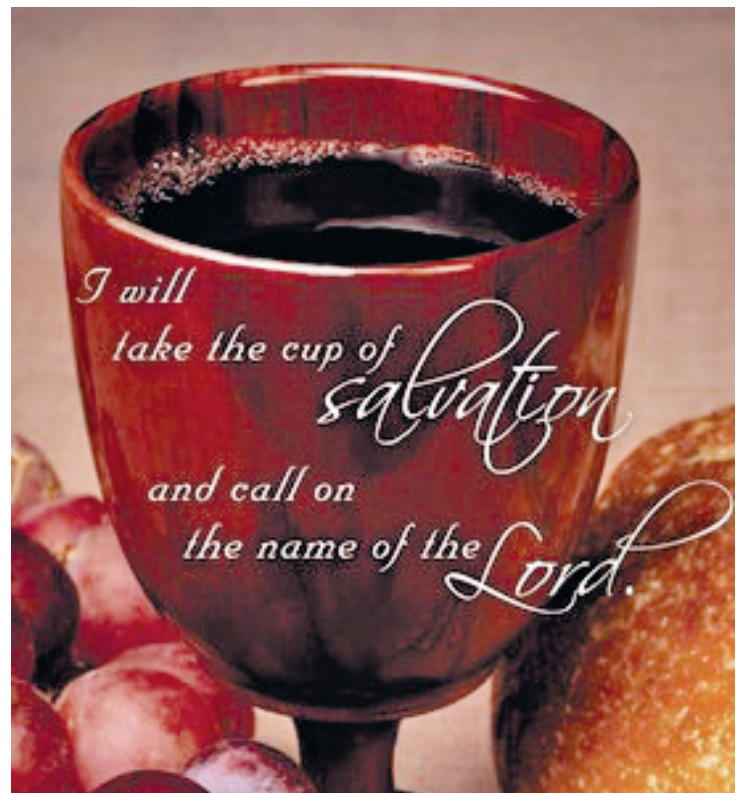
