A MESSAGE FROM FR. STEVE

The Holy Spirit Changes Everything

Over the last few weeks, I have preached a lot about the power of the Holy Spirit. I am excited about what the Lord has been doing in our midst, and am excited about our Healing Encounter (this) Saturday June 9th as well as for all those who are part of the Life in the Spirit Seminar. What our tradition teaches us is that the Holy Spirit changes everything, at least those "things" that are willing to be changed (including us)! The thought is not, of course, original to me. Countless men and women (boys and girls) have experienced the transformational change that the Lord offers us through the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. St. Ignatius of Laodicea drafted these powerful words, which struck me the first time I heard them, and impress me still:

WITHOUT THE HOLY SPIRIT,
God is distant,
Christ stays in the past,
the Gospel is a dead letter,
the Church is simply an organization,
authority a matter of domination,
mission a matter of propaganda,
the liturgical services no more than a reminder of the
past,
Christian living a slave morality.

BUT WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT,

God is with us,
the universe is resurrected
and groans with the birth pangs of the kingdom,
the risen Christ is here,
the Gospel is the power of life,
the Church is the organism,
the Body of the living Christ,
authority is service,
mission is Pentecost,
the liturgy is both memorial and anticipation,
human action is God at work in this world.

Take some time this coming week to muse about why St. Ignatius would say such wondrous things about the Holy Spirit's effects in our world, hearts, and lives.

Prayers for Deliverance

Last weekend, I shared some prayers that a woman who had been involved in the occult prayed, and by which she was freed from harassing evil spirits. The following prayers were those that she prayed. They are powerful. I recommend that if you have concerns about involvement in the occult that you be sure to pray these prayers with a strong believer, or, perhaps better yet, contact me to pray with you. Here are the three prayers:

Prayer for Protection Against Curses, Harm, Accidents

Lord Jesus, I ask Thee to protect our family from sickness, from all harm and from accidents. If any of us has been subjected to any curses, hexes or spells, I beg Thee to declare these curses, hexes or spells null and void. If any evil spirits have been sent against us, I ask Christ to decommission you and I ask that you be sent to the foot of His Cross to deal with as He will. Then, Lord, I ask Thee to send Thy holy Angels to guard and protect all of us (p. 24).

Prayers for Breaking Curses of the Occult

I ask Jesus to bind in His Most Precious Blood any and all evil curses, pacts, spells, seals, hexes, vexes, triggers, trances, vows, demonic blessings, or any other demonic bondages sent against N. or myself, or any of our loved ones or any of our possessions; I ask Him to bind them all and break them. In the Name of the Father and of the Son $\mathbb Z$ and of the Holy Spirit. (Thrice) Ripperger, Fr. Chad. Deliverance Prayers: For Use by the Laity (p. 25).

Breaking Occult Ties

In the Name of Our Lord Jesus Christ, through the merits of the Most Holy Virgin Mary, through the intercession of Saint Michael the Archangel, the Holy Apostles Peter and Paul and all the saints, I ask you God the Father to break every occult tie of black magic (sorcery, curse, etc.) between the foul spirit N. (Name of demon) and N. (Name of person). I ask Thee to bind every power of this spirit and command him to leave N. and go to the foot of the Cross.


