Force on Race and Catholic Schools at:


5:00pm, Wednesday, June 20, 2018 at St Thomas Aquinas Church, 955 Alton Road, East Lansing.



If you have a child who did not received Baptism, Holy Communion, or Confirmation during usual preparation years, our **Children's Christian Initiation classes** will begin in September.


