

A MESSAGE FROM FR. STEVE

Learning about Catholic Funerals

Every family has to eventually deal with the loss of a loved-one. Whether you are anticipating this for your family in the near future or if you don't expect to have to deal with this for quite some time, I believe the upcoming workshop about Catholic funerals will be helpful to you. Representatives from Gorsline Runciman Funeral Homes and St. Joseph Catholic Cemetery will join me this coming Wednesday, July 18th, from 7:00 to 8:30 p.m. in Mercy Hall to address the wide range of issues that families have to deal with when a loved one dies. The presentation is entitled "The Catholic Funeral . . . Factually!" Feel free to invite family and friends who may have questions or just be curious to learn about Catholic funerals.

Updates on Capital Campaign

Thank you for your generous support of the Witness to Hope Campaign, we completed a year ago. As you have seen, we have initial sketches for a potential renovation of the sanctuary. We have presented those plans to the diocese, and I will be meeting with Bishop Boyea and the architect yet this summer to talk about his observations and questions. After a design is approved, we will get bids, and then have several additional steps for official approval of that, our first project of the two that we had as "case elements" for our capital campaign. The second project, the costlier of the two, is the connection between the two school buildings. Once we get the sanctuary project past the approval stages, we will begin working with an architect to develop the plans for the connection between the school building.

Heightened School Safety

In keeping with our commitment to school safety, we will be adding additional security cameras in the school and on the playground. We are also installing *Nightlock Lockdown Door Barricade Devices* in all the school classrooms. In addition to those improvements, we have decided to install a fence, similar to the fencing at Lansing Catholic, with a security buzzer at the north and south ends of the courtyard between the two school buildings. This will allow a greater level of security for the school students during the day. We will have the gates open at night, when the added security is not needed.

Great Free Resource: formed.org

For a few years now, our parish has subscribed to a Catholic formation online portal called "formed.org". If you haven't yet explored the resources, I would definitely encourage you to do so. It provides excellent resources about the Catholic faith, and includes book studies, audio talks, and other, high quality video materials, including quite a few faith-based movies. There is a link from our

website. We have a parish/school code, which will give you access to the website. Our "Parish Code" is **7f0716**. The digit after the "f" is a zero, not an "O.") You will create your own account, using your email address, and then enter the parish code to gain access. If you are a Mac user, I would recommend using Chrome or another browser, rather than Safari. In coming weeks, I will give information about particular series. I would heartily recommend that new series on the Eucharist called Presence.

Upcoming "Two Days of Equipping" for Ministry Training

If you're curious about how to discern and use the gifts God has given you, consider joining us for an upcoming event in early August. Last September, we were blessed to have the team from the John Paul II Healing Center come to present the *Healing the Whole Person retreat*. I am pleased to announce that Bart Schuchts, Bob's brother, who was here last year, will come in early August to offer us a two day (Friday evening and Saturday) conference on using our spiritual gifts for ministry. The description of the program on the JPII Healing Center website is as follows: This training will help you to live a more dynamic and powerful faith. You'll learn how God uniquely speaks to you, and what it means to live in the fullness of Confirmation! Activities include prayer for the release of the Holy Spirit, learning to hear His voice, and practicing praying for others for healing. During this fast-paced training, you will experience the supernatural grace and power that Jesus shared with the apostles, and intends for us today! 
