NOTICE:

In an effort to make a more welcoming entrance to the church and to make event information more relevant and accessible, we will be undertaking a minor project to re-vamp the church vestibule. This project will accomplish the following things:

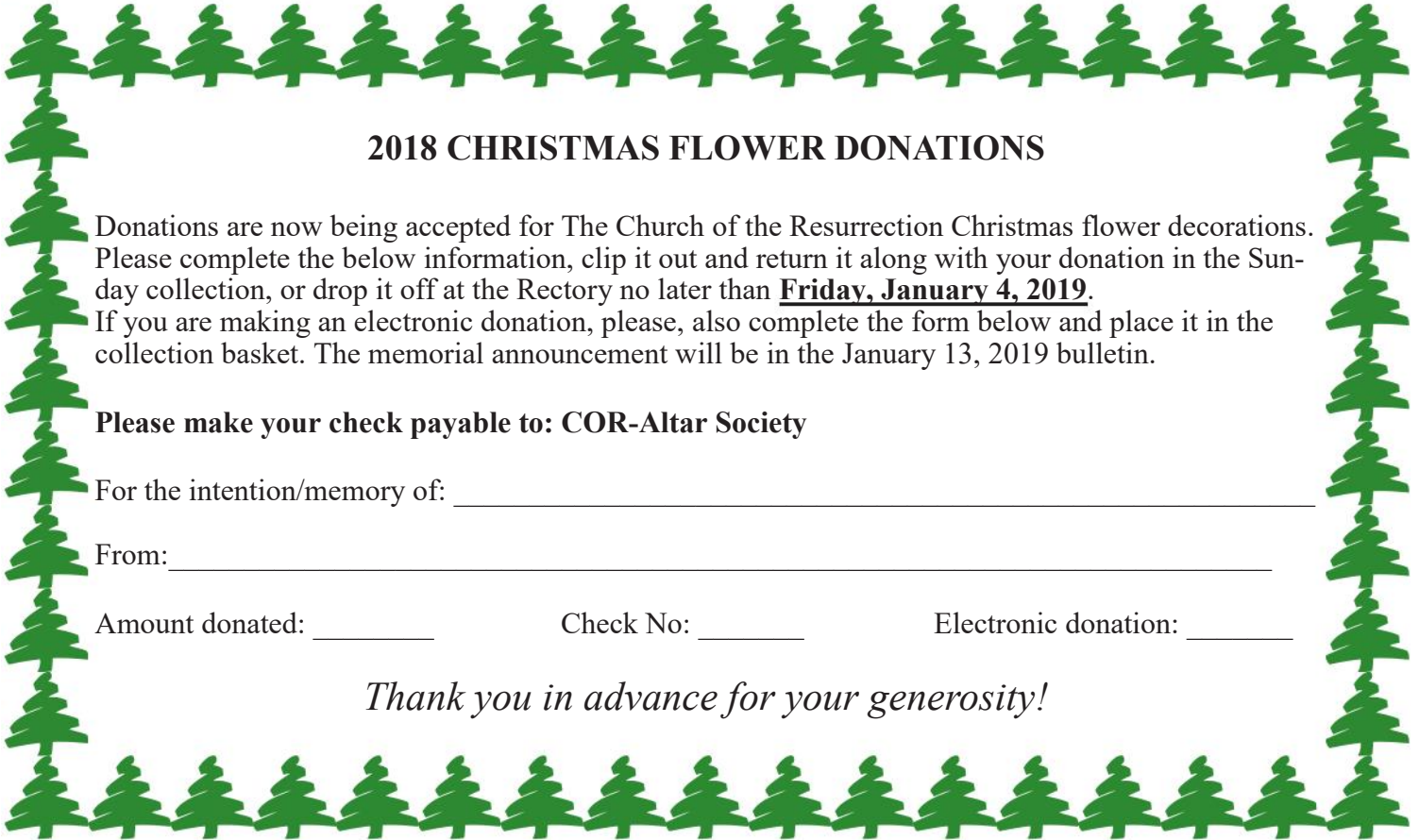
