We will have a Vigil Mass at 4:30 p.m. December 31 as well Mass during the night at 10:30 p.m., followed by adoration and Benediction just prior to Midnight. New Year's Day we will have one Mass at 10:00 a.m.

If those times won't work for you, please check with surrounding parishes to begin the new year well, by praising our Lord. Please note that our offices will be closed on December 24-26 and again on December 31st and January 1st. If you are traveling, may you enjoy the protection of your guardian angels, and have a joyous celebration with your family and friends. God bless you all.
