A MESSAGE FROM FR. STEVE

Thank you!

As we come to the end of our fiscal year, I want to thank all of you who have so generously supported our various ministries through offertory and other donations. Your generosity makes possible the ministries here, and, thanks to you and God's grace, we are bearing fruit together. Thank you!

Changes in Staffing

One of the great graces of the past year has been the growth in our healing prayer ministry. Sean and Liz O'Neill, along with a growing number of others, are taking time with parishioners and others in our community to pray with them for the Lord's healing of their hearts. God is good! After prayerful reflection and discussion, Liz has decided to pull back from her full time responsibilities, and to move to part time status. She will continue to be involved in prayer ministry with Sean, but her responsibilities beyond prayer ministry will be curtailed. I thank her for her years of service as the Director of Evangelization, Discipleship, and Service. Her new title will be Coordinator of Healing Ministry. Sean, who, in addition to his help with the website, has been working on developing coursework for our spiritual formation programs for next year, will move to full time. His new title will be Director of Formation, Outreach, and Ministry. We will have more information about the effects of these changes and the programming opportunities that will be provided in future weeks.

Seven Years

This past Wednesday, I celebrated seven years as pastor of the Church of the Resurrection. As I've said in recent weeks, I'm really enjoying my life and ministry here. I am sure I am the most blessed pastor in the diocese, at least I feel that way. Thank you for your openness and responsiveness to the Holy Spirit. You are a great gift to me and a witness to me and to others in your world. Thank you! As I reflect on these past years, I take great joy in re-reading my first bulletin article from 2012. Here are some excerpts of what I wrote. Please join me in thanking God for His faithfulness and what the Lord has been and is and still longs to do in our midst. Come, Holy Spirit!

Encountering Christ

My priesthood has been marked by a strong desire to help others encounter Christ in a powerful, life-changing way. I am thankful for the long legacy of evangelization, discipleship, and service that has marked this great parish. I look forward to building on the strong foundation that has been established here. Together, let us prayerfully labor to make our parish an even more effective place of genuine encounter with the Love of God.

God is Love

I take these words of Pope Benedict XVI, from his first encyclical, Deus Caritas Est, as a principle that informs my ministry as pastor and Superintendent of Catholic schools: "Being Christian is not the result of an ethical choice or a lofty idea, but the encounter with an event, a person, which gives life a new horizon and a decisive direction Since

God has first loved us (cf. I Jn 4:10), love is now no longer a mere 'command'; it is the response to the gift of love with which God draws near to us." As I see things, our response to this gift of God's love is to strive, by the power of the Holy Spirit, to help others encounter the One who is Love, the One who "draws near to us." As a parish, I hope and pray that together we will strive to grow in our love of God and neighbor and to share that love with others.

First Things First

The ground of encounters with Christ is tilled and fertilized by prayer. Prayer must begin, sustain, and be the end of all our efforts. As Fr. Mark and I begin our service here, we are resolved to continue the strong legacy of prayer at this parish and school. As we move forward, may Resurrection parish (and school) be even more widely known as a place of prayer, a house of prayer, a school of prayer. If that happens, then our various apostolates—our school, the hospital, ministry to the young and old, and especially to the "least of these"—will radiate our witness in this city that so desperately needs Jesus.

Reverence at Mass (Summer Attire Edition)

As we enjoy summer, it is well, at this time of year, to remind everyone about the importance of dressing appropriately for Mass. Most especially on the weekends, shorts are not appropriate attire for worship. Ideally, we would never wear jeans either, in the summer or the rest of the year. Imagine that we are (for we ARE) coming into the presence of our Lord. What would we wear to meet Him and to receive Him "under our roof"? I'm confident that we would wear our "Sunday best" in order to honor Him. Let's encourage each other, and dress modestly and appropriately this summer. This is especially true of those who are exercising various ministries at Mass. Thank you.


