Lisa LaViolette, who has served ably in the role of Director of the Little Shamrocks Preschool program, has taken a position elsewhere, and will be concluding her time of service here August 2<sup>nd</sup>. Please pray for God's choice for this position. Here's the job posting:

Resurrection School in Lansing, Michigan is accepting applications for a full-time preschool/childcare director with lead teaching responsibilities for the upcoming school year. Applicants should have a Bachelor's degree (or higher) and a valid State of Michigan teaching certificate with an Early Childhood endorsement. (ZA, ZS) Prior classroom and administrative experience in preschool, childcare or lower elementary is preferred. Pay will be commensurate to level of education and years of experience. Basic Duties and Responsibilities:

- Plan, organize, direct, manage, and supervise preschool and childcare programs, which includes before and aftercare.
- Collaborate with school leadership and staff on program administration, policies and operational procedures.
- Manage the recruitment, hiring, professional development, and training of staff to ensure the effectiveness of the program.
- *Develop strategic plans to support growth toward enrollment and financial goals.*
- Coordinate curriculum decisions in keeping with the ideals of Catholic education and child development norms.
- Supervision of preschool and childcare staff in providing a nurturing Catholic environment to meet the spiritual, academic, social/emotional, and physical needs of students.
- Ensure compliance with state and diocesan requirements for licensed childcare programs.
- Communicate effectively with parents, staff, prospective families, and the parish in order to promote awareness and support for the program's ministry.

All employees within the Diocese are ministers of the Church, and this position includes religious instruction as part of the curriculum. Therefore, all applicants must be practicing Catholics who are passionate about providing authentic faith formation for their students. Ideal applicants will need to show a sincere love for children, a diligent approach to planning and organizing lessons, an effective understanding of classroom management, a commitment to joyful collegiality, an ability to communicate effectively with parents, and a strong foundation in all facets of the curriculum.

#### Petition Drive About "Dismemberment" Abortion

In coming weeks, we will have petitions available for citizens to sign in order to get a "citizen's initiative petition" on the ballot. Here is the approved summary of the petition: An initiative petition to amend section 90h of the Michigan Penal Code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.90h, to define "dismemberment abortion;" to prohibit a person from performing a dismemberment abortion unless necessary to save a pregnant woman whose life is endangered by a physical disorder, illness or injury; to authorize the legislature to intervene in a lawsuit challenging the constitutionality of this proposal; to allow the spouse of a woman or parent of a minor who obtained a dismemberment abortion to sue for damages; and to prescribe criminal penalties for an individual who knowingly performs an abortion in violation of the proposed initiated law. Let us pray that we will gather enough petitions and that the people of the State of Michigan will vote to ban dismemberment abortions (also known as dilation and evacuation or D&E). This brutal procedure, most commonly used during the second trimester of pregnancy, dismembers an unborn child, removing him or her from the womb limb by limb. In 2018, over 1,900 were performed in Michigan.

#### **Liturgical Changes**

- As I announced last week, Sunday night Compline (which is typically the first Sunday of the month) will be canceled again in August. Compline will return at 8:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 1. Vespers is every week at 7:00 p.m. on Sundays in the church.
- Evenings of Adoration will now be moved to Fridays as a regular matter of course. In other words, Men's Evenings on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Friday of the month, and Women's Evenings on the 4<sup>th</sup> Friday of the month. This will make room for formation talks that will be held on Thursdays.
- We will no longer have the monthly Charismatic Mass on the Second Sundays at 1:30 (including today, July 14<sup>th</sup>).

#### Parable of the Good Samaritan

This week in our Gospel, Jesus gives us the Parable of the Good Samaritan. Clearly, one take away is that we ought to look for ways to be the "Good Samaritan" to others. But more powerful, it seems to me, is to see Jesus as the "Good Samaritan" to us, who cares for us, binds up our wounds, and will (always) come back to "check" on us. Let's let Him serve, and heal us, and, by being healed, heal others too.


