A MESSAGE FROM FR. STEVE

Two Weeks' Bulletins In One

As we anticipated the transition to having Meredith Spalding take over responsibilities as parish secretary on Monday the 22nd, we decided to do "two bulletins in one" to free her up for one week from the bulletin editor responsibilities. This bulletin has the ministry schedules and Mass intentions for both this week and that of the 28th. Please keep Meredith and the entire parish and school teams in your prayers as we make this transition.

New Expanded Office Hours

Beginning July 22nd, our parish office hours will run from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., and 12:30 to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday, and from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. on Fridays. This will be our year-round schedule. This change will allow parents to stop by the office after dropping their children off at school, and will also allow some business hours during typical noon to one p.m. lunch hour. We desire to be more available, and trust that this will be helpful to you and others in our community.

Petition Drive About "Dismemberment" Abortion

In coming weeks, we will have petitions available for citizens to sign in order to get a "citizen's initiative petition," which, if successful, would eliminate the possibility of a threatened veto by Governor Whitmer. Here is the approved summary of the petition: An initiative petition to amend section 90h of the Michigan Penal Code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.90h, to define "dismemberment abortion;" to prohibit a person from performing a dismemberment abortion unless necessary to save a pregnant woman whose life is endangered by a physical disorder, illness or injury; to authorize the legislature to intervene in a lawsuit challenging the constitutionality of this proposal; to allow the spouse of a woman or parent of a minor who obtained a dismemberment abortion to sue for damages; and to prescribe criminal penalties for an individual who knowingly performs an abortion in violation of the proposed initiated law.

Let us pray that we will gather enough petitions that will support the legislature in banning dismemberment abortions (also known as dilation and evacuation or D&E). This brutal procedure, most commonly used during the second trimester of pregnancy, dismembers an unborn child, removing him or her from the womb limb by limb. In 2018, over 1,900 were performed in Michigan.

Mission Appeal Pulpit Swap July 27 & 28

Fr. Louis Ekka will be conducting our annual Mission Appeal the weekend of July 27 and 28th, and I will cover Masses in Swartz Creek on Sunday the 28th for him. Fr. Louis will be raising funds to support the Diocese of Gumla, India, his home. Please give generously in the second collection we will have when he is here. Thanks! Here's information about his diocese:

The diocese of Gumla was created on August 22, 1993. It is in the state of Jharkhand in the North-Eastern part of *India. It was started by the Belgian Jesuit Missionaries.* Because of their selfless service, the diocese is thriving. Today the diocese proudly serves 154,000 Catholics with over 100 diocesan priests and around 55 religious priests. We have convents in all the parishes with about 300 nuns working in schools, hospitals, and orphanages. The missionary work is far from being fully accomplished. The area is vast and the needs are many. More places of worship, schools, and development centers are needed to educate and evangelize the poor and marginalized of the area. Every gift from the heart makes a difference and we thank you for your sacrifices and generosity for supporting the education of our seminarians. Father Louis has been a member of the Lansing Diocese Presbyterate for the past 16 years. 


