## A MESSAGE FROM FR. STEVE

### Opportunities to Serve

Ox Roast is coming! This year, it will be held (as usual) the weekend after Labor Day. (September 6-8). If you would be able to donate some hours to serve in a variety of capacities, that would be a great service to our parish, school, and community. It's always a great event, but it's only possible with the commitment of volunteers from the parish who give some of their time to make it happen. ### Petition Drive About "Dismemberment" Abortion

Beginning this weekend, we will have petitions available for citizens to sign in order to get a "citizen's initiative petition," which, if successful, would eliminate the possibility of a threatened veto by Governor Whitmer. Registered voters in Michigan are eligible to sign, and they should do so only once. Petitions are signed and counted according to the county of residence.

### Fr. Herbert McCabe, O.P.

Last weekend, I preached again about prayer, and I shared some reflections by the English-born Irish Dominican, which I think are very helpful.

*People often complain of "distractions" during prayer. Their mind goes wandering off on to other things. This is nearly always due to praying for something you do not really much want; you just think it would be proper and respectable and "religious" to want it. So you pray high-mindedly for big but distant things like peace in Northern Ireland or you pray that your aunt will get better from the flu—when in fact you do not much care about these things; perhaps you ought to, but you don't. And so your prayer is rapidly invaded by distractions arising from what you really do want—promotion at work, let us say. Distractions are nearly always your real wants breaking in on your prayer for edifying but bogus wants. If you are distracted, trace your distraction back to the real desires it comes from and pray about these. When you are praying for what you really want you will not be distracted. People on sinking ships do not complain of distractions during their prayer (McCabe, God, Christ, and Us, p. 8). Let's keep praying!*

This coming Saturday evening, August 10th, we will have a time of praise, worship, prayer, adoration, and confession from 7:00 to 9:00 p.m. in the church. I will be heading out of town (again to Copper Harbor) that day, so the evening Healing Encounter will be presided over by Fr. Paul Erickson, chaplain of Lansing Catholic High School. The other guests will be Mike & Pico Ball, who will share testimony of Mike's miraculous recovery from a heart attack and over a half hour without blood-flow. I can't wait to listen to the recording of his testimony, but you can hear for yourself as he and Pico share what God did for them. Come, and invite someone to join you. I know that you will be edified. Prayer teams will be available to pray for healing and other requests.

### No Men's Evening of Adoration

A few weeks ago, I mentioned that the evenings of adoration would move from Thursdays to Fridays, which is normally the case. This Friday would, because of this change, be the normal Men's Evening of Adoration. However, because of the Knights of Columbus Vocations baseball game at the Lugnuts Stadium, we have decided to cancel the Men's Evening of Adoration and fellowship following. Confessions and Benediction will still occur, but there won't be a reflection or fellowship following this Friday.

A few weeks ago, I mentioned that Copper Harbor was, in a metaphorical way, my personal "Bethany," a place I go to get renewed in spirit, soul, and body. I'm heading there again, this time with my brother Dan, to enjoy tech-free beauty and renewal. Please pray for me as I take time away. Be assured of my prayers for you.
