A MESSAGE FROM FR. STEVE

Jesus Christ is King!

We come to the end of our Liturgical Year by celebrating the Reign of God manifest in Jesus Christ our Lord and King. Our entire life as Christians is ordered to hope and anticipation of Christ's return and our own fellowship with Him in Heaven. Our home is in Heaven, and the King who is to come is our Brother, our Friend. If we walk always by His side, following Him, accompanying Him in our daily choices, we have no reason to fear His return. He will welcome us into His Father's House.

Advent Begins Next Sunday

What a great transition we find at this time of year! Right after we celebrate Christ's Kingship, we begin to anticipate His coming in three ways: His Incarnation (coming as a baby for us), His coming again in glory, and His coming in our hearts. It is a holy season of anticipation. To assist you in your preparation, please take a booklet filled with meditations for each day of Advent. May we all enter deeply into this great season of hope. Feel free to take a copy of the Magnificat Advent Companion, at the various exits.

Reflections on Church and State Politics

Last weekend in my homily, I addressed the challenges of our time in both the Church and in our politics at the national level. As I mentioned in my preliminary comments, I had wrestled in my heart and prayer about whether I should preach the homily I gave. In the end, as I mentioned, I felt that the Lord was inviting me to address our political moment, as fractious as it is. My fundamental concern is that one can easily be caught up in the strident partisanship of the current moment, and be tempted to care more about one's party and/or its policies than the dignity of the other person or what is good, true, and beautiful. Just like others in our current context, the temptation can be to listen to our favored news source or commentator, taking what they report as "true" just because they are on "our side." Let us be more prayerful about how to respond in our current context, and ask the Lord to help us see (and hear) others as sons and daughters of God, who possess dignity.

Healing the Whole Person Retreat in Brighton

We were blessed to have this retreat at our parish a couple years ago, and I'm grateful that the John Paul II Healing Center will be coming to Michigan again this year. I very much encourage people to take the time to "Be Healed" over these three days. Please share the information with those you know and love. As I preached last week, healing encounters with the living love of God can help all of us deal with the various challenges of life.

From 7:00 to 8:30 next Saturday, December 7th, we will have an "Evening of Renewal." The evening will consist of a time of Praise and Worship, then a talk by Sue Cummins. This is a wonderful opportunity to experience the freedom of praising God together, using the charismatic gifts of the Spirit, and being enriched by the word of God. I will be leading the evening and the event will take place in the church.

Come Encounter Jesus

In two weeks, on December 14th, we will have our next Healing Encounter. It is a time of praise, worship, prayer, and adoration from 7:00 to 9:00 p.m. in the church. It's a great opportunity to worship God and to open our hearts to have Him do healing work in us. Come, and bring others with you. Prayer teams will be available to pray for healing and other requests. Come, and invite someone to join you.

Thanksgiving

Eucharist means "thanksgiving," and we especially pause this week to say "thank you" to God. This week, families across our Land will celebrate God's gracious gifts to us. I continue to pour out my heart of thanks for all God has given me by sending me to the Church of the Resurrection. I am grateful for your prayerful support, your financial support of the parish and school, and your generosity in service. My prayer for you is that you will experience the delight that our God takes in you as you pour out your thanks to Him. May your time of celebration be filled with love, joy, and peace. We will have Mass on Thanksgiving Day at 8:15 a.m. Join us if you're able. We will have the opportunity for prayer on Friday, but note that we will not have exposition until the Holy Hour from 7-8 p.m.
