A MESSAGE FROM FR. STEVE

Diocesan-Wide Survey

As I pointed out a few weeks ago, every adult in parishes across the diocese will soon be invited to complete an online (or paper) survey called the "Disciple-Maker Index," a survey that will provide helpful data to assess the current climate and health of the diocese (and parishes in the diocese). The survey is available on the main page of our website. We will have paper copies of the survey available for you to complete a week from today after the 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. Masses in the parish hall. Or you can contact the office to get a copy. The survey takes 10 to 15 minutes to complete, and the results will be invaluable to me, the staff, and our many volunteers as we seek ways to best support everyone in their discipleship journey. I look forward to sharing the findings with you when the project is complete. Thanks in advance for your help with this.

Daddy-Daughter Dance

On February 22nd at 5:30 p.m., fathers (or fatherfigures, i.e., grandfathers, uncles, god-fathers, etc.) are invited to accompany girls in the parish and school, Kindergarten or older, to join in a Ceili Dance. 40 Days for Life (Begins Ash Wednesday)

Beginning Ash Wednesday (2/26), another 40 Days for Life campaign will begin. This year the site of prayers will be the Planned Parenthood facility in Frandor. I am grateful for the strong commitment to pray and serve among our parishioners, and invite all of us to keep this in our prayers throughout Lent. This nationwide effort has born tremendous fruit, and I am hopeful that we will see the closing of this facility very soon. Works of Mercy

The Catechism highlights the Works of Mercy in paragraph 2447:

The works of mercy are charitable actions by which we come to the aid of our neighbor in his spiritual and bodily necessities. Instructing, advising, consoling, comforting are spiritual works of mercy, as are forgiving and bearing wrongs patiently. The corporal works of mercy consist especially in feeding the hungry, sheltering the homeless, clothing the naked, visiting the sick and imprisoned, and burying the dead. Among all these, giving alms to the poor is one of the chief witnesses to fraternal charity: it is also a work of justice pleasing to God.

That is a great list of ways that we can fulfill the Servant of God, Dorothy Day's, exhortation that "everything we do should be either directly or indirectly related to the spiritual and corporal works of mercy." Living that way would be a remarkable witness, and prove that we are truly "salt, light, and leaven" in the world. Come, Holy Spirit!




