A MESSAGE FROM FR. STEVE

Forty Days of Lent

This Wednesday, we begin again the Holy Season of Lent to prepare our hearts for the profundity of Holy Week. As we prepare for forty days of Lent, let us all fast, pray, and give alms for our own conversion, our parish, and our community. This is a moment of grace and opportunity, for us to be witnesses of the truth and the power of conversion. May we all pray and fast for others, that all men and women would yield their will to the will of the One who is truly Lord of Heaven and Earth. Please grab a copy of the *Magnificat Lenten Companion on your way out this weekend*.

Fasting for Him

As a reminder, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of Fast and Abstinence. In the Church, the minimum required fast, which applies to those between the ages of 18 and 59, is to refrain from eating between meals and to limit their eating to one full meal and two lighter meals that do not add up to a full meal. The law of abstinence (refraining from eating meat) applies to those 14 years of age and older. *All Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. Let me encourage you to see these days of fasting and abstinence as an invitation to deepen your hunger for God and to discipline the appetites of the flesh.*

Ash Wednesday and Beyond

There will be three Masses on Ash Wednesday at which we will distribute ashes. Come pray with us, as we begin our Lenten Journey together. The Masses will be held at 8:15 a.m., 12:00 noon, and 6:30 p.m. See the bulletin for other opportunities to pray more this Lent. Each Friday, we will pray the Stations of the Cross in the church at 6:30 p.m.

40 Days for Life (Begins Ash Wednesday)

Beginning Ash Wednesday (2/26), another 40 Days for Life campaign will begin. This year the site of prayers will be the Planned Parenthood facility in Frandor. I am grateful for the strong commitment to pray and serve among our parishioners, and invite all of us to keep this in our prayers throughout Lent. This nationwide effort has born tremendous fruit, and I am hopeful that we will see the closing of this facility very soon. Please join us for the 40 Days for Life Kick-off meeting at South Church (5250 Cornerstone Dr., Lansing) on Monday, February 24th at 6:30 p.m. A showing of the film *Unplanned, about Abby Johnson*, will follow at 7:20 p.m. You can sign-up this weekend and next after the 9:00 and 11:00 Masses.

Diocesan-Wide Survey

As I pointed out a few weeks ago, every adult in parishes across the diocese will soon be invited to complete an online (or paper) survey called the "Disciple-Maker Index," a survey that will provide helpful data to assess the current climate and health of the diocese (and parishes in the diocese). The survey is available on the main page of our website.

We will have paper copies of the survey available for you to complete today after the 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. Masses in the parish hall. Or you can contact the office to get a copy. The survey takes 10 to 15 minutes to complete, and the results will be invaluable to me, the staff, and our many volunteers as we seek ways to best support everyone in their discipleship journey. I look forward to sharing the findings with you when the project is complete. Thanks in advance for your help with this.

Parish-Wide Ceili Dance (March 7)

On March 7, we will have a parish-wide evening of dancing. It will be a potluck. All the parishioners are invited to attend. It is a potluck, and doors open at 6, and dinner will begin at 6:15. We'll eat and then have a dance demonstration by McCartney Irish Dance. Then we will all have a chance to learn simple Irish Ceili Dances, with easy-to-follow instructions by Meghan of McCartney Irish Dance. No need to RSVP.
