A MESSAGE FROM FR. STEVE

Fun Fundraiser for the Shamrock Club

Tonight (Saturday night, 3/14), you are all invited to take part in the Fifth Annual Bean Bag Toss Tournament, a fundraiser put on by our Resurrection Shamrock Club, which supports the athletic program here. Join us. It's a great evening of food, fellowship, and fun. Registration is from 5:00-6:00 p.m., and the tournament will begin at 6:00 p.m. The tournament has both child & adult divisions. It's a great evening.

Coronavirus, Covid-19

Last weekend, I took time to talk about coronavirus, but fear that the emphasis of the homily was more about personal preparedness than about trust in God and finding ways to be salt & light in our world. That, I think, was the more important point, and I regret not having made that the emphasis. Given the dynamics of risk for those who are older and/or have underlying health challenges, we want to be a parish that supports them as family. If you know of anyone who is "self-isolating" and needs help, please let the parish office know. We will have hand sanitizer at the entrances for Mass and at the hall for use at events. Let's, of course, keep all of this, especially our health care workers, policy-makers, and those who are suffering from Covid-19, in our prayers.

School and Pre-School Guidelines

In light of the diagnoses of several people who have the coronavirus in Michigan, Jacob Allstott (principal), Laura Demko (director of preschool), and I have sent a memo home to families in our school and preschool about those (staff, volunteers, and students) who have symptoms. Here are the guidelines that went into effect on Friday:

- *If a faculty member, staff member, volunteer, or student has symptoms, such as fever, cough, sneezing, respiratory problems, difficulty breathing, extreme exhaustion, muscle or body aches, chills, diarrhea will remain out of school for 48 hours due to a recent student at Resurrection with a confirmed case of the norovirus. They may return earlier if a doctor has confirmed the diagnosis and has advised when it is safe for them to return to school.*

- *Daily deep cleaning of all surfaces in the classrooms and lunchroom, as well as heightened recommendations for "elbow coughing," hand-washing, and use of hand sanitizer to prevent the spread of any germs, have been put in place. We will also clean the pews in church regularly to prevent the spread of germs.*

- *We ask everyone to be mindful of the CDC's recommendations for traveling as we approach spring break. There are many who have already booked travel, but at least some airlines are allowing rebooking of tickets without penalty as a result of the coronavirus.*

In general, we recommend that everyone keep abreast of guidelines and recommendations from the CDC (coronavirus.gov) as you make decisions about self-isolation, self-care, and travel. Let's keep each other in prayer!

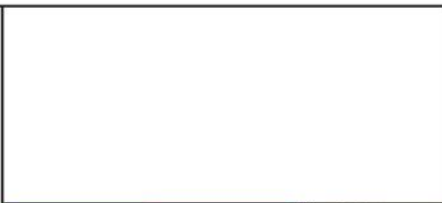
