I'm glad to welcome our new Preschool Director, Judie Mirabelli-Migaldi. She is a parishioner, and we're glad to have her step into this important role. Last year, Laura Demko took on the role of Director, but she and her family discerned that it would be best for her to remain home with their soon-to-arrive baby. We thank her, for her leadership, and for her role in strengthening the preschool program. We are pleased that Judie said yes to this invitation, and are confident that she will provide the sort of continuity in our program that Laura worked to establish. It's wonderful to have "believers" in these roles. Please pray for Judie and the preschool staff as they anticipate the next year.

#### **Resurrection School Plans**

This past week, Jacob Allstott (school Principal) and I sent a letter to families who have registered for the school or who were enrolled last year to inform them of our plans for opening in the fall. We have prayerfully considered Governor Whitmer's guidelines and have determined that we will proceed with inperson instruction when the Lansing region is in "Phase 4" or higher. The Lansing School District has decided that they will begin the school year using remote learning, but our hope and prayer is that we will be able to provide as much in-person instruction as possible. The uncertainties are, obviously enough, real, but our hope and prayer is to be able to have "as normal as possible" school year beginning, as originally scheduled, on August 25. At this point, we are planning to limit enrollment to one classroom per grade, and are open to additional families for the school, should families be interested in partnering with us in the formation of their children in the faith. As we continue to make plans, I ask that you please pray for the faculty, staff, and families who are part of Resurrection School. Come, Holy Spirit!

#### **Reminder: From the Ox Roast Committee:**

After months of careful thought and prayer, we the members of the Ox Roast Committee have decided that the safety of our parish members and of the community come first. So we the Ox Roast Committee are recommending not holding the Ox Roast this year. This decision was not made

lightly. We considered many ways of having an Ox Roast, but given the regulations, changing rules, and lack of state offices open, our hands were tied. We make the commitment to the parish that we will have the best Ox Roast ever next year. Thank you and stay well.

#### Love of God and Neighbor

Beginning this past Thursday, we began our most recent formation course. You can find the first talk on our formation page. The next talk will be held at 7:00 p.m. in the church (and by livestream) on Thursday, July 30th. The final talk will be August 6th. Let's pray for each other, that we will know how best to support each other in loving God and neighbor.

#### **Racial Healing and Reconciliation**

Please continue to pray for me, for other religious and civil leaders, as we continue to discern how best to bring healing to the wounds that have recently been exposed, aggravated and/or caused over the past few months. This has been an area of prayer and study, and conversation for me over the past few months, and I am grateful for conversations I have had with several concerned Black Catholics. The honest give-and-take has been helpful to me. My desire as pastor here is to grow in my own appreciation of the hardships, slights, and outright prejudice that they have experienced both within and outside of the Church, and to find ways to move forward in terms of living as

brothers and sisters in Christ. I remain convinced that the healing work that the John Paul II Healing Center has taught me contains fundamental insights and processes that can help us as a parish, community, etc., which, if we can implement it, will provide a way to

be salt, light, and leaven in the world, as we demonstrate what love of neighbor looks like.




