### Thank you, team!

I want to take time to honor and thank the great team of men and women on our staff who have worked so tirelessly to get us ready for the new school year. Just some of the many things included upgrades to our cleaning procedures, myriad logistical details and procedures, installation of UV light fixture installation, and arrangements for "cohorting" of the students. I'm grateful to have such a wonderful team to work with. God has blessed us abundantly.

### **Technology and Spiritual Warfare**

A couple weeks ago, the problems with our livestream began at the Vigil of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. They've continued, despite periodic success in getting things to work. Part of this is the challenge of upgrading to a new phone system, I'm sure, but the problem between Saturday at 5:00 and Sunday morning at 9:00 was very suspicious. It was a bad AC adapter for the converter from fiber to ethernet. I'm sure that happens, but I've never seen it before. In any case, that part of the problem has been solved, but we're still grappling with challenges with our "streaming box" after a firmware update. Hopefully by the time you read this things will be fixed, but I'm not ready to bet on that. The Lord has been teaching me a lot through this, and I want to learn to "let go" of my expectations and demands, to entrust myself and this ministry more fully to God. The key for me now is to become holy and to pray more so that I can, in fact, "In all circumstances give thanks, for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus." Here's the very end of First Thessalonians, truly words to live by (and memorize):

We urge you, brothers, admonish the idle, cheer the fainthearted, support the weak, be patient with all. See that no one returns evil for evil; rather, always seek what is good [both] for each other and for all. Rejoice always. Pray without ceasing. In all circumstances give thanks, for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus. Do not quench the Spirit. Do not despise prophetic utterances. Test everything; retain what is good. Refrain from every kind of evil. May the God of peace himself make you perfectly holy and may you entirely, spirit, soul, and body, be preserved blameless for the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. The one who calls you is faithful, and he will also accomplish it. Brothers, pray for us [too]. (I Thes. 5:14-25)

### Going Deeper, Always Deeper

On Wednesday, we had yet another frustrating problem technologically, this time with the audio feed during the broadcast of the Mass. After Mass, I was reminded that I needed to practice what I preach, which is to "Give thanks in all circumstances." Indeed! Once again, I realized that things like that are easier said than done! I'm more convinced than ever that God gives me (and you too!) multiple opportunities every day to look for God's active love in our lives, even when it's most difficult.

### Crosses—freely taken up

This Sunday, Jesus gives a difficult word to St. Peter (and to each and every one of us): "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me." It's a challenging word, but thankfully, the Lord Himself invites us also to come to Him when we are burdened and heavyladen. He is walking by our side, always, and invites us to share our hearts with Him, as He shares His heart with us.

### Lord, help us bear our crosses with and for you!

As I've prayed about this, I've been humbled by realizing how relatively minor my "crosses" are compared with many of you, who are wrestling with huge trials, personally or in your families. Please forgive any of my shortness or inattentiveness in brief interactions as I've tried to "fix it." I need to keep relearning that "one thing is needful," which is love. I hereby recommit myself to praying more for all of you and with the Lord, so that I can receive more love from Him and share that love more effectively with all of you. Please keep me in prayer. I'll do the same for each of you!
