The Holy Spirit Changes Everything

Over the last few weeks, I have preached a lot about the power of the Holy Spirit. What our tradition teaches us is that the Holy Spirit changes everything, at least those "things" that are willing to be changed (including us)! The thought is not, of course, original to me. St. Ignatius of Laodicea drafted these powerful words, which struck me the first time I heard them, and impress me still:

God is distant, Christ stays in the past, the Gospel is a dead letter, the Church is simply an organization,

the liturgical services no more than a reminder of

Christian living a slave morality. BUT WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT,

God is with us, the universe is resurrected and groans with the birth pangs of the kingdom, the risen Christ is here, the Gospel is the power of life, the Church is the organism, the Body of the living Christ.

authority is service, mission is Pentecost, the liturgy is both memorial and anticipation, human action is God at work in this world.

Take some time this coming week to muse about why St. Ignatius would say such wondrous things about the Holy Spirit's effects in our world, hearts, and lives.
