Today, we pray for the Holy Spirit to come . . . *fill the hearts of the faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love* . . . Just what we've been praying for years. As I've said more than a few times over the past years, "Come, Holy Spirit" is a prayer that the Holy Spirit can't resist. He comes! May we be those who open our hearts to receive with an open heart, mind, and will the power of the Holy Spirit.

The Holy Spirit Changes *Everything*

Over the last few weeks, I have preached a lot about the power of the Holy Spirit. I am excited about the Lord has been doing in our midst, and am excited about our Healing Encounter (this) Saturday June 9th as well as for all those who are part of the Life in the Spirit Seminar. What our tradition teaches us is that the Holy Spirit changes everything, at least those "things" that are willing to be changed (including us)! The thought is not, of course, original to me. Countless men and women (boys and girls) have experienced the transformational change that the Lord offers us through the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. St. Ignatius of Laodicea drafted these powerful words, which struck me the first time I heard them, and impress me still:

*WITHOUT THE HOLY SPIRIT,
 God is distant, Christ stays in the past,
 the Gospel is a dead letter, the Church is simply an organization,
 authority a matter of domination, mission a matter of propaganda,
 the liturgical services no more than a reminder of the past,
 Christian living a slave morality.
 BUT WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT,*

*God is with us, the universe is resurrected
 and groans with the birth pangs of the kingdom,
 the risen Christ is here, the Gospel is the power of life,
 the Church is the organism, the Body of the living Christ,
 authority is service, mission is Pentecost,
 the liturgy is both memorial and anticipation,
 human action is God at work in this world.*

Take some time this coming week to muse about why St. Ignatius would say such wondrous things about the Holy Spirit's effects in our world, hearts, and lives.
