Interested in learning more about the Catholic Church?

Each fall, as we begin a new season of learning, we also begin programming for those who are interested in learning more about the Catholic faith. This year, Rich Budd will be teaching classes for adults as well as high school students who are interested in learning more and potentially becoming Catholics at the Easter Vigil in the spring. Rich’s full time job is Director of Family Life for the Diocese of Lansing. He helped out with the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) classes last year, and I’m grateful that he will be serving the parish in this way. RCIA will be held on Monday evenings, beginning October 4th. Once again this year, Susan Bartold will be working with those students up to 8th grade who are interested in learning more about and/or becoming Catholic at the Easter Vigil in the spring. Sacramental Preparation for First Communion, Confirmation

Programs for preparation for First Reconciliation and First Communion, as well as for Confirmation will be starting soon. There will be a parents’ meeting for Confirmation Preparation on September 26th after the 8:00 a.m. Mass, and the preparation will begin on October 10th, again, after the 8:00 a.m. Mass. RRM Feedback Sought

Last Sunday evening, we had an event at the four high schools of the diocese to talk about the recommendations

for “parish groupings” throughout the diocese. The grouping that has been proposed for us is as follows: St. Mary Cathedral, St. Therese, St. Andrew Dung Lac, and Resurrection. If you didn’t have a chance to watch the video presentation, you can still do so. (I recommend that you watch it all, because it places the groupings and the entire RRM process in a broader, mission-focused context.) You can go to the diocesan website for their YouTube channel. The survey instrument is included in the chat box toward the end of the video presentation. You can fill out the survey through the end of the day Monday, September 6.

Adoration on Fridays

Thanks to all of you who spend time with Jesus on Fridays during adoration from 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. You give a great gift of yourself and your time when you spend time in prayer before the Lord. Your prayer is a gift to the Lord, to our parish, and to our community. For all those reasons, I’m very grateful that we have been able to offer this day of adoration each week. Unfortunately, we have recently been struggling to get every hour covered by at least two people. As a result of having only one person per hour, staff members are having to call to get people to commit to fill the slots with at least one person. Please share the word that we need to have people commit to an hour each week, or we may not be able to continue to offer adoration until we get those commitments. It is too risky that people will need to leave without having someone who can take their place. We can’t, of course, allow Jesus to be left alone on the altar!

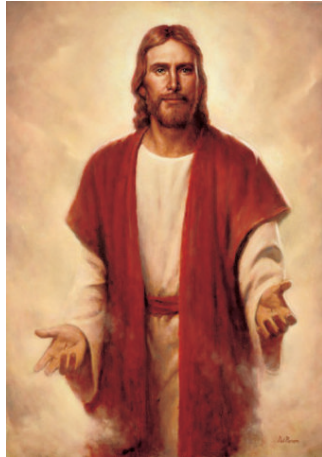
Hiring for Substitute Teachers
