## Right to Life of Ingham County Focus on Life Dinner

Please plan to join us for this dinner, which will be held here at our own Mercy Hall, Monday, September 20. The doors open at 6:00 p.m.. Dinner and the program begins at 6:30 p.m. The U.S. Supreme Court will hear a critical case this fall, Dobbs v. Jackson Center, that challenges the core of the Roe v. Wade decision. Right to Life of Michigan filed a "friend of the court" brief, requesting in no uncertain terms, that Roe be overturned. The keynote speaker for the Right to Life of Ingham County Focus on Life dinner is Professor William Wagner, president of the Great Lakes Justice Center, who led the team writing RLM's brief. A renowned constitutional expert, former federal magistrate, and distinguished law professor, William Wagner will provide direct insight into the legal strategy attacking Roe v. Wade. Resurrection School is looking to hire substitute teachers. Substitute teachers are paid \$80 per day, and it is a wonderful service to the school and the teachers.




## Women's Weekend Retreat: Rediscovering Jesus September 17-19, 2021
