Upcoming Formation Series: “The Tradition of the Church”

Our six-week Winter-Spring formation course, presented by Dr. John Yocum, is entitled: “The Tradition of the Church.” The aim of the course is to understand the notion of Tradition in general and the unique place of Scripture in the life of the Church, and to take a glance at four great figures who embody that Tradition in their works: St. Athanasius; St. Basil; St. Augustine; St. Thomas Aquinas. Course dates: February 17, 24, March 3, 10, 17, 24. The series will be taught by Dr. John Yocum has a Doctorate in Theology from The University of Oxford. He has taught Theology at Oxford, at Loyola School of Theology in Manila and currently teaches at the Sacred Heart Catholic Seminary in Detroit, Michigan. Synod for a Synodal Church

Last weekend, I played an audio version of Bishop Boyea’s homily that invited us into the process of the “Synod for a Synodal Church.” In coming months, we will have opportunities to engage with a variety of issues as members of the Church of Lansing. We ran out of materials to hand out this weekend, and we hope to get more in coming weeks.

Conversation Guides (and conversations themselves)

The more that I reflect on the conversation guides, I realize that it’s pretty intense. I want to make sure that you don’t feel duty-bound to follow the guide in detail. It’s a pretty intense “interview style” of conversation, and I want to make sure that you and those with whom you speak feel as comfortable as possible. Please also see if they are comfortable having you share (anonymously, of course) what they tell you with the diocese for this purpose.

Latin *Novus Ordo* Mass

Given that this is the second Sunday of the month, the 11:30 a.m. Mass today will be celebrated in Latin. This is the *Novus Ordo* Mass, which is the “ordinary form” of the Mass, but it will be celebrated in Latin. The “propers” of the Mass will be in English. Mass

responses can be found in the St. Isaac Jogues Missal at page 253 (the off-white pages). As I mentioned this past summer, we will celebrate one 11:30 a.m. Mass per month in Latin.

Blessings and Woes

This weekend, we hear St. Luke’s version of the Sermon on the Mount. It includes both blessings and “woes,” which are sobering to us in the West. May we be among those who are in Christ and live lives that are blessed and to avoid the woes that Jesus declares for those who are rich, well fed, comfortable, and in good standing with the world!

And raising his eyes toward his disciples he said:

*“Blessed are you who are poor,
for the kingdom of God is yours.
Blessed are you who are now hungry,
for you will be satisfied.
Blessed are you who are now weeping,
for you will laugh.
Blessed are you when people hate you,
and when they exclude and insult
you,
and denounce your name as evil
on account of the Son of Man.*

Rejoice and leap for joy on that day!

Behold, your reward will be great in heaven.

For their ancestors treated the prophets in the same way.

*But woe to you who are rich,
for you have received your
consolation.*

*Woe to you who are filled now,
for you will be hungry.*

*Woe to you who laugh now,
for you will grieve and weep.*

*Woe to you when all speak well of you,
for their ancestors treated the false
prophets in this way.”*
