Visiting our Seminarians

Last weekend, I was out of town to celebrate my nephew, Caleb's, wedding to Marie DeMarais in St. Paul. While I was there, I was able to visit the seminarians from our parish and the diocese who are studying at St. John Vianney at the University of St. Thomas in St. Paul. The seminarians from our parish are Mason Abbott, Brandon Amburn, and Thomas Crowley. It was wonderful to see the campus, and the seminary building, and to make Holy Hours and concelebrate Mass with the seminary community while I was away. The rector of the seminary and another priest on staff both made their 30 Day Ignatian Spiritual Exercises the same place and time I did. It's a small (Catholic) world. Please continue to pray for our seminarians and all those who are being formed at St. John Vianney in St. Paul, as well, of course, as all the seminarians throughout the world.

Pine Hills Camp

While I was in St. Paul, Thomas Crowley and a fellow seminarian told me that they are going to be on staff at the Pine Hills Camp this summer, which is held at the YMCA camp in Jackson. Pete Burak, of Renewal Ministries, is the director of the camp this year, and I have always heard great things about the experience that students have at camp encountering the love of God. In the past the camp has been ecumenical, but this year, its 40th, it has changed and is explicitly Catholic. The boys' camp this year is June 12-18, and spots are available for students entering 7-9th grades. You can get more information and register at their website (pinehillscamp.com). The cost for the week is \$465. They do have some scholarship assistance available, but we are happy to provide \$100 for those who wish to attend this camp, just as we have with the Catholic Youth Summer Camp.

Keep on Praying!

As you are surely aware, there was some violence last weekend in various places around the country, as well as a tabernacle that was stolen with the Blessed Sacrament inside. These activists have made themselves our enemies, but we are bound, commanded even, to pray for them. Persecution is no surprise for Christians, and our job is to pray for those who persecute us and do good to them, forgiving them for their wrongs to us are those who stand with us. Since the *Dobbs* decision is still in the balance, let us be diligent in praying about the deliberations among the Supreme Court Justices regarding the ruling in the *Dobbs* case. Let us also continue to pray that all of who employ euphemisms about "abortion care" will come to see the truth about the human dignity of all those who are victims of abortion, most of all the innocent children who have suffered and died over the past fifty years. Come, Holy Spirit!

Let MI Kids Learn Petition Drive

The Let MI Kids Learn petition drive is underway to promote educational justice legislation. Michigan children from low-income families would qualify for "Student Opportunity Scholarships" toward their out-of-pocket educational costs at public or nonpublic schools for tutoring, school supplies, computers, and tuition among other expenses. Donors to scholarship organizations would receive a state tax credit. Low-income parishioners and members of our community would benefit from this initiated legislation, regardless of where they send their children to school. The petitions would place this proposal before the legislature, and, if approved, would not require the governor's signature to become law. As this is a nonpartisan effort, Catholic parishes and schools are allowed to circulate petitions. The Catholic Bishops of Michigan support this effort. Please prayerfully consider signing the two required petitions to create the scholarship program and tax credits to improve the education of Michigan's school children.

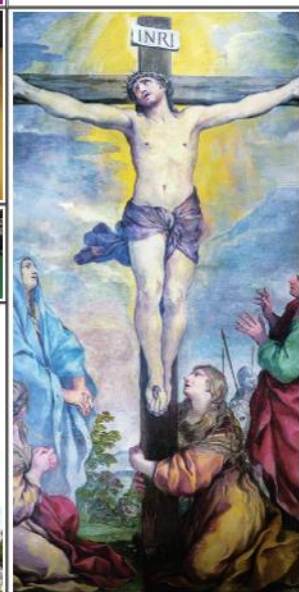
