The promise is true for us as well, that we will be "receive power." May we and all believers be open to a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit this Pentecost. We are called, each and every one of us, to be his witnesses. Let us tell others our story, and help them come to know the love of God and the power of the Holy Spirit. Come, Holy Spirit!
