Our liturgies owe a tremendous amount to St. Thomas Aquinas, a Dominican priest and Doctor of the Church. He was brilliant and prayerful and he handed on to us the fruits of his contemplation, in true Dominican fashion.

Corpus Christi Procession Today

Today, after the 11:00 a.m. Mass, we will have a Eucharistic Procession, singing songs of praise to Jesus, our Eucharistic Lord. May the Lord have mercy on us and bless as we lift Him high in our neighborhood and parish.

Need for More Eucharistic "Adorers" on Friday

A few months ago, I mentioned that we don't have sufficient numbers of adorers to ensure that someone will always be present during the hours of adoration on Fridays. Regrettably, because we don't have assurance that we will have adorers all the hours throughout the day, we are going to have to suspend adoration on Fridays until we get two people signed up as regular adorers for each hour on Fridays. (Individuals can sign up for an hour on Fridays on our website.) Most Fridays, we will have a Holy Hour from 5:30-6:30 p.m. even when there is no adoration throughout the day. (See note about my time away below.)

Reduced Mass and Confession Schedule June 24-July 6

A year ago, I had hoped to attend Fr. Joe McGill's ordination to the priesthood for the Diocese of Paisley in Scotland. (Fr. Joe is Liz and Sean O'Neill's nephew.) Because of travel restrictions, however, I was unable to go. Thankfully, that ticket I purchased a year ago is going to be used, and I'll be traveling to Glasgow, and thankfully be able to spend a week in the Highlands with Sean, Liz, and other friends. I will be leaving the evening of June 23rd and flying back on July 6th. While I'm gone, we will only have weekend Masses and confession times. In other words. Masses and confessions will be canceled on the following days: Tuesday, June 28, Wednesday, June 29; Thursday, June 30; Friday, July 1 (morning and evening); Tuesday, July 5, and July 6. Thankfully, there are plenty of daily Masses and confession times in the Lansing area. I recommend that you check out masstimes.org to find area Mass & confession times while I'm gone. Please note that we will have Mass at 8:15 a.m. on June 24, which is the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus and the last day of Vacation Bible School.


Open Doors Tutoring Center
