Divine Renovation

Fr. James Mallon, a priest of the Archdiocese of Halifax in Canada, wrote a book with the title Divine Renovation: From a Maintenance to a Missional Parish. It came out a year after Rebuilt: Awakening the Faithful, Reaching the Lost, and Making Church Matter, by Fr. Michael White and Tom Corcoran. Both of these books have been influential in discussions of parish renewal and shifting Catholic parishes to a more robust evangelistic and formational focus on the mission. These books, and most especially Divine Renovation, have been invaluable to us as a parish as we have pursued the Lord's leading here in the heart of the City of Lansing. I found the material and the tone of Divine Renovation, and we have used the "Divine Renovation Method" of formulating vision, goals, strategy, and tactics, as a parish, including our Leadership Team.

Divine Renovation Conference

I'm giving that background because I am writing this article from my hotel room near Dallas Fort Worth airport on the last day of the Divine Renovation USA (DR USA) Conference, which was held at St. Ann Catholic Church in Coppell, Texas. The parish has 8000 families, and the campus is huge. It's perfectly set up to hold such a conference with a remarkable number of large rooms for breakout sessions. The parish showed us remarkable hospitality, and the DR USA team did a wonderful job with organization. The conference was a great opportunity for members of our Leadership Team and parish staff to have meaningful and effective messages about the call from the Lord for us to "Go and announce the Gospel of the Lord!" The 130 priests gathered, with 500 others who are members of parish staff and volunteers, were invited to meditate on what God is doing, and how the Holy Spirit is drawing others (like us) deeper into this great "Missional Path." We came with members of four other parishes and Craig Pohl from the diocese, and had great times of fellowship and prayerful discussion about the work of renewal in our diocese. Mary Healy gave a powerful presentation on the power of the Holy Spirit, and she invited us to recommit to being entirely surrendered to the Lord in doing the work of sharing the Good News and making disciples. It was a powerful presentation. Later this morning, Peter Herbeck will be the final speaker, and will call us to engage in this, which is "our moment." As forecast, the heat was incredible, with a high of 110 degrees over the three days we were here. The lows were in the high 80s. Despite the heat, it was a beautiful three days. I look forward to prayerfully discerning, with others from our parish staff and members of other parishes and Craig Pohl about how to proceed to more effectively become a "missional parish." Please join me in praying for the members of the DR team, and the many priests and lay faithful who attended the conference. Thanks!
