Mission Appeal Next Sunday

Fr. Roger Chikri is a priest of the Maronite Order of the Blessed Virgin Mary. He serves as one of the Chaplains at the Ave Maria Foundation in Ann Arbor. Next Sunday, he will be giving our annual "Mission Appeal" to support the work of the Church around the world. I look forward to meeting him and to hearing him preach at the Masses next weekend. In anticipation of his presentation, he sent me the following. I invite you to read through this, and to prayerfully consider giving generously to support their work in Lebanon. Thank you!

Lebanon, a country that is cited in the Bible more than 71 times, is being purged of Christians and is currently facing an existential threat. As Christians, we know that divine providence will never forsake this beloved country, especially now in its darkest moment. In solidarity, we come to you seeking your prayers and economic support for those remaining and to bolster their spirits having to live under such harsh circumstances and conditions.

Every morning, priests from our religious community in Lebanon, The Maronite Order of the Blessed Virgin Mary, awaken to an expanding number of families in need with nowhere to go but to us. We are not able to sufficiently meet the needs of these suffering souls. We are graciously asking you to help us to help them. The horrible blast of August 4, 2020 in Beirut and the collapse of the Lebanese currency, diminished supply, and peak prices, including but not limited to food, medicine, and fuel have undermined human dignity in a disturbing way. The disruption of vital services (electricity, water, internet, and wireless sector) is endangering many lives and putting the upbringing of our children and eventually Catholic education at peril.

Your contribution will be distributed as food packages to helpless individuals and families. Medicine and special medical needs will be supplied to people with serious health conditions. Your donations will allow children in the poorest families to continue their schooling.

Together we can safeguard this land where our Lord Jesus Christ set foot and where Christianity dawned and flourished. We strongly believe that Christianity is not just the land but a community witnessing to our Catholic faith. Please help us remain in our land which also belongs to you in faith.


