Beginning at 3:00 p.m. at Bethany House in DeWitt, there will be a BBQ and time for fellowship and prayer for those young men (and even those not so young) who are curious about seminary and/or feel a call from the Lord to give their lives in service to the Lord. If you are a junior in high school or older who has wondered if God might be inviting you to consider the priesthood, please call me, email me, or talk to me after Mass. I'd love to answer any questions you might have, and also would love to have you join me, other priests, seminarians, and others who are discerning God's call in their lives, for a time of fellowship and prayer. And let me thank families in advance for their support of sons and brothers who discern the priesthood, and daughters and sisters who are discerning the religious life.
