## Ox Roast Is Near

Next month, we will hold our 87th Ox Roast Festival this September 9-11. Each year, the parish serves the community, our parish, and our school in this way. It's an opportunity for fellowship and fundraising. Thank you for your support in past years.

To mark our 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary, we are having a Super (Duper) Raffle with a grand prize of \$20,000. The other prizes are \$5,000, \$2,500, \$1,000, \$1,000, and \$500. 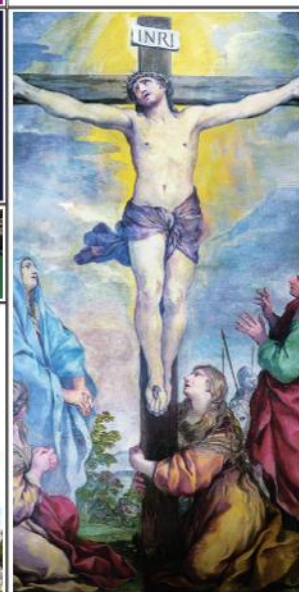
