

Ox Roast Is Near

Next month, we will hold our 87th Ox Roast Festival this September 9-11. Each year, the parish serves the community, our parish, and our school in this way. It's an opportunity for fellowship and fundraising. Thank you for your support in past years.

To mark our 100th anniversary, we are having a Super (Duper) Raffle with a grand prize of \$20,000. The other prizes are \$5,000, \$2,500, \$1,000, \$1,000, and \$500. The drawing will be held Sunday of the Ox Roast weekend, September 11 at 4:00 p.m. We now have a link on our website. You could also buy one at the parish office or purchase a ticket after Sunday Masses.

In the past, we've sent packets of twenty-five \$2 tickets to every parishioner, with a top prize of \$2,000. We're hoping that this year, to celebrate our hundred years, everyone might consider splurging—really, <u>investing</u>—in the parish as we look forward to our second hundred years. As an incentive, we are offering a \$1000 prize for the seller of the most tickets, and \$500 for the seller of the grand prize ticket. (You can name someone as the seller or claim that for yourself, say, if you purchase a ticket or tickets online or after Mass.)
