Annual Convocation of Priests of the Diocese of Lansing

Beginning Monday afternoon, Bishop Boyea and the priests of the diocese will have their annual Priest Convocation. The dates are Monday, October 3 through Thursday, October 6. Because all the local priests will be out of town, we will not have Mass on Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday. We will also not be hearing confessions at our normal times. If you would, please keep Bishop Boyea and me and my brother priests in your prayers this week. Thank you!

Revised Sunday Mass Times (beginning October 15-16)

Please note that two weeks from now, we will shift the Sunday morning Mass times to 8:30 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. This will allow confirmation preparation, which will begin at 9:45 to follow the early Mass and finish before the later Mass. This arrangement will give confirmation preparation families the option of attending either morning Mass. Please note that we will add a 5:00 p.m. Sunday Mass beginning that weekend, as well. The Sunday evening Mass will allow our "parish grouping" to offer a Sunday evening Mass. We will retain our Saturday evening 5:00 p.m. Mass.

Daily Mass Changes

Beginning Monday (10/17), I will celebrate a Monday morning Mass at 8:15. There will be no Tuesday Mass or confessions. The Wednesday Mass will be an evening Mass, celebrated at 6:00 p.m., followed by confessions from 6:30 to 7:30 (concluding with Benediction). Perpetual Help devotions will be prayed at 5:45 p.m. on Wednesdays. We will still have our monthly 6:30 a.m. Mass on Wednesdays on the first Wednesday.

Save the Date! Resurrection Life Course Begins October 20

Our Resurrection Life course is a 5-week course created by the Church of the Resurrection. It presents the wonderful message of the gospel and offers participants with a way of opening

themselves to the powerful and liberating experience of new life in Christ through the Holy Spirit. The course begins on October 20. The format for each evening includes a meal, short prayer time, a talk, discussion time, and closes with a final prayer. The night begins at 6:30 pm and ends at 8:30 pm. The course includes a Friday-Saturday offsite experience at the Colombiere Retreat Center in Clarkston, Michigan. The sessions cover topics such as God the Father, God the Son, God the Holy Spirit, forgiveness, the Gifts of the Holy Spirit, and Life Everlasting. You can register online. The dates of the course sessions are: Oct. 20 & 27, Nov. 3, Nov. 11-12 (off-site), Nov. 17. This is a great opportunity to grow deeper in your own faith, or to invite others who may not know the Lord to come, spend some time with others, and to have an encounter with the love of God.

This is Pro-Life Sunday, and we are invited to participate in a peaceful prayer chain witnessing to the sanctity of life. Please gather along Grand River Ave. from Abbot Rd. to Williamston – meeting at Abbot Rd., Brookfield Plaza, Summit Bank near Okemos Rd., St. Martha Church or Main St. in Williamston near St. Mary's Church. The peaceful prayer event will be held from 2:30-3:30 this afternoon, asking God to bless our efforts to promote the sanctity of all human life. If you do not have a smartphone and wish to access the church during the hours of 10:00am-3:00pm on school days, there will be a sign with a number to call and you will be connected to someone who can let vou in.


