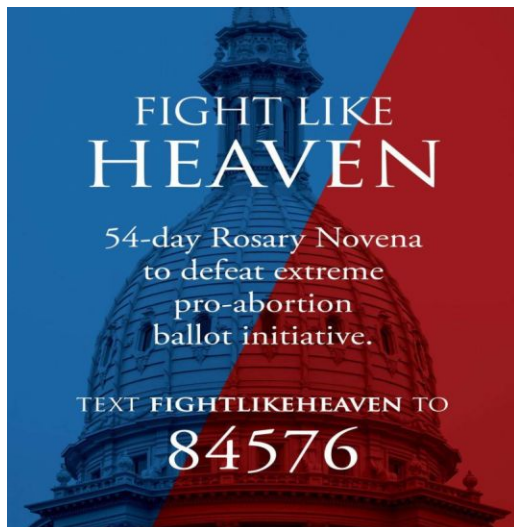

Solemnity of All Saints

Tuesday, November 1, with all the Church, we celebrate the Solemnity of All Saints. This year, it is a Holy Day of Obligation, so we will offer three Masses, one at 8:15 a.m. (School Mass), one at 12:00 Noon, and one at 6:30 p.m. We remember the saints and call upon them as we pray the Mass. May we be “caught up” in the hope we have as we celebrate our brothers and sisters who have “made it home” to heaven.

Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (All Souls)

November 2 is All Souls’ Day, when we pray for all our beloved dead, that they will be purified of any attachments to the things of earth. We fail in our charity if we neglect to pray for those who have died. One wise priest, when asked when we should stop praying for our deceased loved ones, said (as if it were obvious), “When they’re canonized.” Until then, let’s not stop praying for them. We will offer three Masses that day, one at 8:15 a.m. (School Mass), one at 12:00 noon, and one at 6:00 p.m. (See note below about Mass for those who have died in the last year, which will be celebrated at 11:00 a.m. on November 19th.)

Hundred Year Anniversary Dinner (November 19)

Tickets will be available after Mass on Sunday and also online for the Celebration Dinner, which will be catered by Soup Spoon Café. The doors will open at 6:00 p.m., and dinner will be served at 7:00 p.m. It will be a wonderful time and meal. The tickets are limited, and we hope to sell out. Tickets for are \$50 a piece and \$25 for Seniors (60 and up). I will be inviting members of the clergy who have served here to join us, and am excited to celebrate our hundred years with many of you. You can get more information and purchase tickets on our website.

We would like to be able to show some of these at the dinner on the 19th, and then make them available for the remainder of the year on the website. Praying for the Dead

November is a month when we remember our loved ones who have died. There is a book near the statue of Mary (and the baptismal font) for you to list family members whom you wish to remember in prayer this month. We will also be offering Masses, as stated above, for our loved ones on November 2, All Souls’ Day. *Please note that I will offer Mass at 11:00 a.m., November 19, for all parishioners who have died between November 2, 2021 and November 1, 2022.* If you have a loved one who has died this past year, please let Meredith know, and we will include your loved one in the Eucharistic Prayer as we pray for the dead by name. Feel free, of course, to invite families to join us for this Mass. Every time we pray for the dead, we perform one of the spiritual works of mercy. May they rest in peace!

Sunday Chanted Compline (Night Prayer)

Please join us this Sunday evening at 7:00 p.m. in the church for an evening of beautiful chanted music. David Stattelmann, our Music Director, has been working with a Schola which will chant the Extraordinary Form of Night Prayer (Compline). Come, enjoy the beauty and end the Lord’s day with chanted Night Prayer.

2023 GUIDELINES FOR SCHEDULING MASS INTENTIONS

POLICY & PROCEDURE

- ◆ Mass stipends are \$10 and are to be paid when requesting Masses. Payable by check or exact change only.
- ◆ Limit of 6 Masses per parish family may be requested for the year, (up to 2 of these can be for the Sunday obligation)
- ◆ Only 1 intention per Mass is allowed, per Canon Law. However, to better accommodate the needs of our parishioners, we can list up to 2 first names with the same last name (e.g. John & Mary Smith) **OR** 2 last names (e.g. Jones & Smith Families)
- ◆ No Mass will be permanently affixed in the Mass Book until the stipend is received.
- The first stipend received is assigned the date.

SPECIAL NOTES TO REMEMBER

- ◆ One Sunday Mass per weekend is offered for the intention of the Parishioners of Resurrection.
- ◆ Have an alternate date/time in mind.
- ◆ Please note that scheduled Masses may need to be moved to another date/time due to the availability of our priest.
- ◆ All Mass intentions over 6 requests will be sent to a Mission assigned by the Diocese.

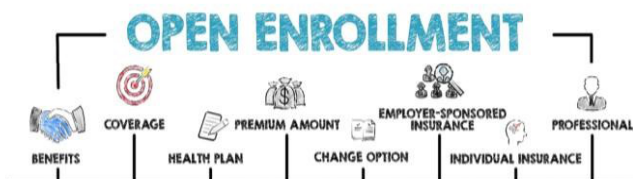
