December 8 is the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, and is a Holy Day of Obligation. We will have three Masses to celebrate the Immaculate Conception, a Vigil Mass at 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, and two Masses on Thursday, one at 8:15 a.m. and the other at noon.

Reflections on Advent Penances 2022

As you have heard many times, I preach to myself, and everyone else gets (has!) to listen. Last Sunday, I preached a message that I felt I needed to hear. You can listen to it on our website. Recent developments and recent "sudden deaths" have me thinking quite a bit about preparedness. We simply don't know how much time we have left. This is one of those "longest" Advents (four full weeks), and I'm planning to make the most of it, in terms of pulling back from areas of distraction, in order to pray, read, and spend time with others in person and to detox from the virtual stimuli that so easily disturbs us, pacifies us, or tempts us to areas of self-indulgence and sin.

Inconvenience & Acedia

A central thrust of my homily was the danger of convenience and comfort. Our current technology is dangerous for us spiritually, I absolutely believe, because it eases of us toil and effort, it satisfies our desires almost without effort. This is the source of my cautions about remote starts, heated seats, Alexa, Echo, Siri, one-click purchases, cashless purchases, smartphone apps, etc. Each of these (and other "advancements") may make our lives easier, but not necessarily better. In passing in my homily, I mentioned the microwave and dishwasher as potential sources of unhelpful ease. But I realized when I pulled out the dish rack that using my dishwasher (and microwave) make my life easier, it is true. But avoiding their use would not make my life actually better. All of that to say, I've decided to continue to use the dishwasher, since avoiding their use won't help me live better.

Live Better

That's the point. When we pull back from this or that technology, the goal should be to live a more real, person-to-person, existence, and to know the dignity of work. Let us use these four weeks to reboot our spiritual lives and live better in ways that prepare our hearts (and those of those we love) for His coming at Christmas, and at the end of time. I think less digital makes us better. More making and less buying makes us better. I think doing hard things (all things considered) makes us better. Let's not ease our way through Advent, but take seriously the call to reflect on our lives and to help ourselves and those we love become more human, more loving, more active, less passive, as we "stand erect" waiting for the Lord's return.

Come Encounter Jesus

Next Saturday, December 10th, we will have our next *Healing Encounter*. It is a time of praise, worship, prayer, and adoration from 7:00 to 9:00 p.m. in the church. It's a great opportunity to worship God and to open our hearts to have Him do healing work in us. Come, and bring others with you. Prayer teams will be available to pray for healing and other requests. Come, and invite someone to join you.

WORLDWIDE WOMEN'S ROSARY

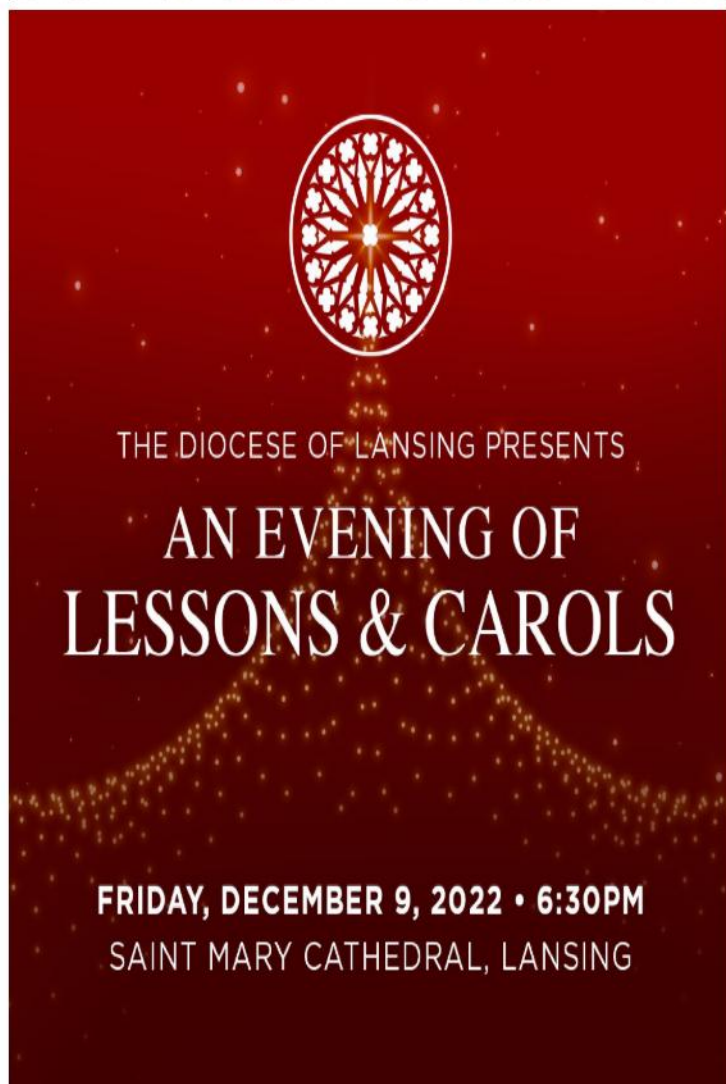
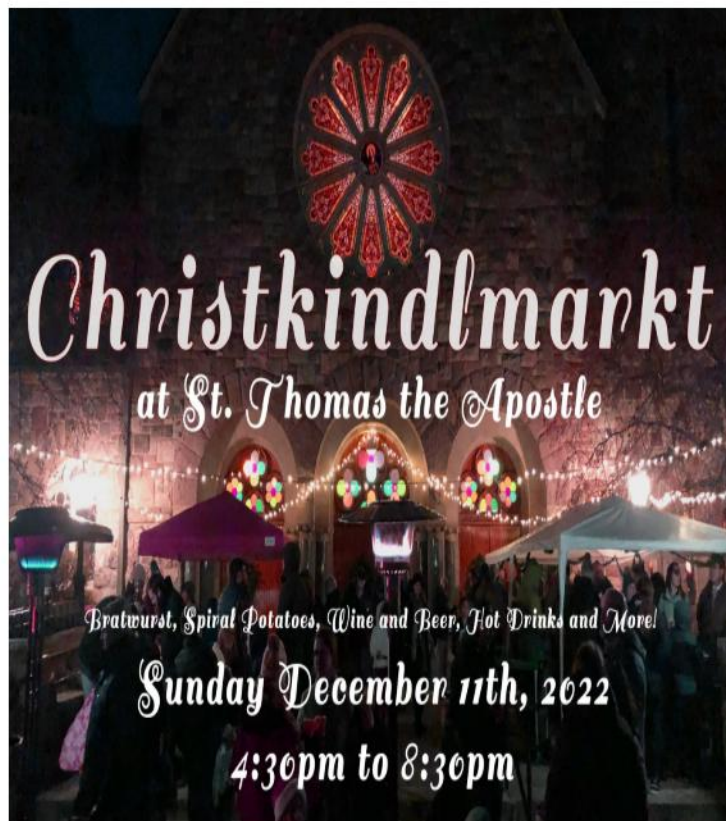

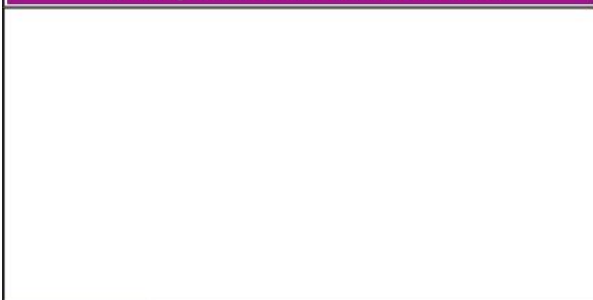
