Important Upcoming Formation Opportunities

Please carve out time to join us in a couple of weeks for presentations which will be held February 15-17. Fr. Sean Kilcawley, a priest of the Diocese of Lincoln, Nebraska, will be in Lansing to present to students, parents, and teachers about the challenges of growing up (and forming children) in the 21st Century. We can't really exaggerate the challenges of living (and growing up and raising children) in what he (rightly) calls a hyper-sexualized culture. Fr. Kilcawley studied at the JPPI Institute for Marriage and Family and has certification as a *Pastoral Sexual Addiction Practitioner* from the International Institute for Trauma and Addictions Professionals. His presentation to parents will be Wednesday evening at 7:00 p.m. in the Lansing Catholic HS auditorium. The title of his talk that evening will be "Living the Gospel of the Family." *Pope Benedict XVI once wrote, "In our times as in times past, the eclipse of God, the spread of ideologies contrary to the family and the degradation of sexual ethics are connects. And just as the eclipse of God and the crisis of the family are linked, so the new evangelization is inseparable from the Christian family."* In this talk Fr. Kilcawley will unpack these words from Pope Benedict and provide tools and insight to help parents in their role as leaders of the domestic Church in the midst of the hyper-sexualized culture. On Thursday morning, he will give a presentation to middle school and high school students from 9:15 to 11:15 a.m. in the church. The title of his talk is "Jesus Is Enough for You." He will also give a formation session for teachers on Friday. Please pray for Fr. Kilcawley and for those who will hear him present during his three day visit next week. And join us, if you're able!

Catholic Schools (Five Marks)

Last weekend, I preached about the five marks of Catholic schools. I thought I'd offer them to you for your review. Please do pray for our school, and for all Catholic schools, that we will more and more fulfill the Lord's vision and purpose for our school. Thanks!

1. Inspired by a Supernatural Vision: *There is an emphasis on the inalienable dignity of the human person, called to life in Christ through the Holy Spirit, called to fulfill our destiny to become saints.*

2. Founded on Christian Anthropology: *Because of our supernatural destiny, we are called to a life of holiness; grace builds upon nature. Founded on Jesus Christ, the Redeemer, the imitation of Christ is our model and means; Christ is **the** Teacher. We are called to life in and through the Church.*

3. Animated by Communion and Community: *The school is a community of persons; a community of faith. Community is defined in these four areas:*

- *Teamwork among all those involved*
- *Cooperation between educators and bishops*
- *Interaction of students with teachers*
- *Physical environment (including visible sacramentals, prayer, worship, etc.)*

4. Imbued with a Catholic Worldview throughout its Curriculum: *Guided and inspired by the Gospel, Catholic education is intentionally directed at the growth of the whole person. Genuine Catholicity must permeate every aspect of the education and community, focusing on a love for wisdom and a passion for Truth.*

5. Sustained by Gospel Witness: *It is the primary responsibility of the principal and teachers to create a Christian school climate; they are called to participate in the Church's evangelizing mission. The nobility of the task to which teachers are called demands that, in imitation of Christ, the only Teacher, they reveal the Christian message not only by word but also by every gesture of their behavior.*
