Formation Course on Liturgy

Have you ever wondered about how the Eucharist came into being? Ever puzzled over the symbolism of the different parts of the Mass or the various sacred vessels the priest uses? Ever mused about the approach to liturgy at the Church of the Resurrection? All these questions and more will be teased out in this 3-part series on liturgy. I'm excited to welcome back our Formation Courses. Beginning this Thursday, March 16, and continuing the following two Thursdays (23 & 30), Jeremy Priest will present the following three talks on liturgy:

- Covenant Renewed: The Mass in Scripture According to Pope Benedict XVI
- Avoiding Idolatry: Space, Time, and Sacraments
- And I Turned to See a Voice – Posture and Orientation in Encountering the Lord in the Liturgy

The talks will begin at 7:00 p.m. and will be held in the church. Please note that we will not be livestreaming these presentations. Jeremy Priest is the Director of the Office of Worship for the Diocese of Lansing, as well as Content Editor for *Adoremus*. He holds an STL from the Liturgical Institute of the University of St. Mary of the Lake, Mundelein, IL. He, his wife Genevieve, and their children are parishioners of the Church of the Resurrection and live in the Groesbeck neighborhood.

Our Diocesan Services Appeal is one such opportunity to give God thanks for his great gifts; for the work of the Church in our own lives and in lives across our diocese. Diocesan-Wide Survey

As we did three years ago, every adult in parishes across the diocese are invited to complete an online (or paper) survey called “Disciple-Maker Index.” This instrument was developed by the Catholic Leadership Institute as part of a Lilly Foundation grant-funded program to understand parish life from a leadership perspective. This survey will provide helpful data to assess the current climate and health of the diocese (and parishes in the diocese). We will get data comparing our parish with others in the diocese, and with national averages. The survey includes Mass attendance, spiritual disciplines, and beliefs. Responses to the survey questions will be confidential. The survey takes about 10 minutes to complete, and the results will be invaluable to me, the staff, and our many volunteers as we seek ways to best support everyone in their discipleship journey. I look forward to sharing the findings with you when the project is complete. There are pew cards with a QR Code for your use to complete the survey. If you would like a hard-copy of the survey, please contact the parish office. Thanks in advance for your help with this. We would love to have a high percentage response rate.

The Woman at the Well

This week in our Gospel, we hear the powerful encounter of Jesus with the woman at the well. The exchange between them represents beautifully how Jesus deals with sinners, and the offer He always makes to satisfy the hunger and thirst of all of us. Each of us seeks to have our various “thirsts” satisfied, but only God can fully meet our needs. St. Augustine famously wrote, “You have made us for yourself, O Lord, and our hearts are restless until they rest in you.” Like the woman, we seek to quench our hearts thirst in various ways, but only Jesus, to whom all thirsts and hungers ultimately point, can satisfy. Jesus invites this woman to move beyond the shame of her sinful life to trust in the truth found in Jesus. He offers her the “living water” of love and mercy, which can quench her heart’s thirst. Jesus offers us the same living water, which can satisfy us, if we will, like the woman at the well, only believe.
