Mass Time Survey (8:30 or 9:00 a.m.?)

As many of you know, we have shifted around Mass times multiple times over the past few years. Much of that had to do with the challenges of Covid, as well as arranging for sufficient time between the earlier and later morning Masses to allow confirmation preparation to fit between them. Today (Sunday), the 2023 confirmation class for our parish will be confirmed by Bishop Boyea. Please pray for them! Next year our plans are to have most of the confirmation preparation occur in 8th grade religion class or a home-school formation program, combined with specific formation sessions for the school and parish candidates to meet and grow together in anticipation of confirmation.

Details about that formation course are yet to be determined. However, we are open to moving the earlier Sunday Mass to 9:00 a.m. from the current 8:30 a.m. time if most parishioners prefer that time. In order to make this determination, we ask you to fill out the online survey for Mass times or call the parish office to let Meredith know your "vote" on the question. Just to make things clear, the question is whether we should retain the 8:30 time or shift it a half hour to 9:00 a.m. We will make this change, if that is the result of the survey, the Sunday after the school year is finished, which will be June 4. Please submit your vote no later than May 18. I will announce the results of the survey at Masses the weekend of May 21. Thank you.
