Visiting our Seminarians

I am writing this from St. Paul, Minnesota, where the college seminarians from our diocese and fifteen other dioceses study. St. John Vianney Seminary is part of the University of St. Thomas. I traveled now because I wanted to visit Mason before he graduates and as Charlie Gates gets close to completing his first year. On Tuesday, I concelebrated Mass in their beautiful chapel, and found myself looking forward to our completed renovation, when that day comes. Fr. Dan Westermann is flying to MSP today (Wednesday, May 8), and he and I will take out all of the Lansing men this evening for dinner. If you would, please keep seminarians from our parish (including Thomas Crowley in Rome), and all seminarians in your prayers. Next Saturday, seven men will be ordained to the "transitional diaconate," which means that they will transition from deacons to priests at their priestly ordination next June. God willing, of course. It is a great blessing to contemplate having two more priests this year and seven next year.

A Culture of Vocations

I hope and pray that the Church of the Resurrection will become an increasingly supportive context and culture in which vocations to the priesthood and religious life can be fostered and nurtured. Families, please encourage your sons (and brothers and uncles and grandsons) to prayerfully consider whether the Lord might be calling them to the priesthood. And please pray that I will be a shepherd with the heart of Jesus.


