#### **Twelve Years**

This Wednesday, I will celebrate twelve years as pastor of the Church of the Resurrection. I am happy to be here, and feel as though I may be the most blessed pastor in the diocese. Thank you for your openness and responsiveness to the Holy Spirit. You are a great gift to me and a witness to me and to others in your world. Thank you! As I reflect on these past years, I take great joy in re-reading my first bulletin article from 2012. Here are some excerpts of what I wrote. Please join me in thanking God for His faithfulness and what the Lord has been, and is, and still longs to do in our midst. Come, Holy Spirit!

#### **Encountering Christ**

My priesthood has been marked by a strong desire to help others encounter Christ in a powerful, life-changing way. I am thankful for the long legacy of evangelization, discipleship, and service that has marked this great parish. I look forward to building on the strong foundation that has been established here. Together, let us prayerfully labor to make our parish an even more effective place of genuine encounter with the Love of God.

#### God is Love

I take these words of Pope Benedict XVI, from his first encyclical, Deus Caritas Est, as a principle that informs my ministry as pastor and Superintendent of Catholic schools: "Being Christian is not the result of an ethical choice or a lofty idea, but the encounter with an event, a person, which gives life a new horizon and a decisive direction . . . Since God has first loved us (cf. I Jn 4:10), love is now no longer a mere 'command'; it is the response to the gift of love with which God draws near to us." As I see things, our response to this gift of God's love is to strive, by the power of the Holy Spirit, to help others encounter the One who is Love, the One who "draws near to us." As a parish, I hope and pray that together we will strive to grow in our love of God and neighbor and to share that love with others.

#### **First Things First**

The ground of encounters with Christ is tilled and fertilized by prayer. Prayer must begin, sustain, and be the end of all our efforts. As Fr. Mark and I begin our service here, we are resolved to continue the strong legacy of prayer at this parish and school. As we move forward, may Resurrection parish (and school) be even more widely known as a place of prayer, a house of prayer, a school of prayer. If that happens, then our various apostolates—our school, the hospital, ministry to the young and old, and especially to the "least of these"—will radiate our witness in this city that so desperately needs Jesus.

As I mentioned last weekend, there have been times I have only heard that someone had been seriously ill only after they died. We may not have up-to-date information for everyone, so I'd invite you to call or complete the form, regardless of whether you believe you are (or your family member is) "on the list." You can call or fill out information on our website. The form asks for names, addresses, phone numbers, and a contact number of a family member. Note: If your loved ones (or you yourself) are admitted to the hospital, please call the office (517.482.4749). You can leave a message with Sarah or you can dial extension 106, which will connect you to my cell phone. Feel free at any time to dial extension 106 when there is an emergency and someone needs the sacrament of the sick (anointing).

I'm out of town this weekend, and will return in time for the 6:00 p.m. Mass on July 3rd. Please note that we will not have devotions or our regular "First Wednesday Mass" on the 3rd. All the other Masses and confession times have been covered, thanks be to God. The parish office will be closed July 4th and 5th in celebration of Independence Day. As usual, we will have the 8:15 a.m. Mass. Please pray for our nation, especially that our Religious Liberties will be respected long into the future.




