### Mission Appeal Next Weekend

Each year, we have a “mission appeal” during the summer. Next week, we will have the appeal, and I want to encourage us all to give generously to the work of the Church in Uganda. Naomi Corera will be here to talk about the work in her native Uganda, and to ask us to support the Church there. Naomi founded a ministry called “Children Waiting Everywhere,” and you can see information and some videos on their website ([childrenwaitingeverywhere.org](http://childrenwaitingeverywhere.org)). Here is a summary of her ministry, which is in the Diocese of Fort Portal, Uganda:

#### Who We Are

*We are a Catholic and ecumenical 501(c)(3) foundation dedicated to serving our brothers and sisters around the globe by sharing our blessings, and empowering them through education and self-employment. We serve one community, one family, and one child at a time, contributing to projects in microeconomics, education, and health. We are building up the lives of children waiting everywhere.*

#### Why We Are 100% Volunteer

*Naomi Corera, CWE Founder and Spearhead: When my lawyer sent me his bills for working on making us a 501(c)(3) foundation, I noticed he had N/C after each statement. When I questioned him why he was putting my initials at the end of each bill – he laughed and said, “Naomi, it is not your initial, it means No Charge! So let’s keep it that way.” So it remains: no charge for everything and for everyone who works for this foundation. By the grace of God it has been that way since we began in 2000! No salaries, no rent, no travel expenses – all the work being done by generous donors who give of their time and talent. The items they are seeking to have us help them fund are as follows:*

*Our main goals with funds raised will be for... providing much needed water...*

- 1) Water tanks/gutters, materials for the ministry base (\$2,500).*
- 2) Catholic Education in rural areas supporting Nursery/Primary Schools.*
- 3) Prenatal care for pregnant mothers and safe delivery in the new Divine Mercy Hospital.*
- 4) Assisting seminarians with their education.*
- 5) Vocational training for those unable to continue higher studies.*

We will take a second collection next weekend, and will add a drop-down option on the online giving portal for donations to be sent to them. Make any checks written to us, with a memo line of either “mission appeal,” or “Uganda.” We will make sure that the funds get to them.

### Meditating on Ephesians 1:3-14

We have a great second reading this week, and I invite everyone to take time reflecting and meditating on the mystery contained therein. Thanks be to God, we really have been blessed by God in and through our baptism. The challenge for us is to let those baptismal and other sacramental graces come alive in us in response to our openness, faith, and belief in Jesus, who is Lord of heaven and earth. Here are some important excerpts, with my emphases:

*Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavens, as he chose us in him, before the foundation of the world, to be holy and without blemish before him . . . . In [Christ] we were also chosen, destined in accord with the purpose of the One who accomplishes all things according to the intention of his will, so that we might exist for the praise of his glory, we who first hoped in Christ. In him you also, who have heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and have believed in him, were sealed with the promised Holy Spirit, which is the first installment of our inheritance toward redemption as God’s possession, to the praise of his glory.*

Because I know that many Christians don’t realize the great dignity that they have as baptized sons and daughters of God, I took time to go word-by-word through some of Paul’s beautiful (and deep) letter to the Ephesians, hoping to encourage everyone to believe that they could, in fact come to “know and love our Lord Jesus Christ in a personal way.” That’s my passionate prayer and hope for parishioners and others who have not yet had a chance to meet Jesus.

#### “Go in peace, glorifying the Lord by your lives.”

That final blessing and command at the end of Mass reveals the connection of the Mass (and our faith) with the mysteries Paul is unfolding in his letter to the Ephesians. We are, each and every one of us, chosen by God for His purposes, “to the praise of his glory.” We are living as “little Christ’s” in the world, just as Jesus did, for the praise of God’s glory. Let’s help each other believe and live in light of that great truth!
