### **Eucharistic Congress**

Today, the National Eucharistic Congress concludes in Indianapolis, and I rejoice that our parish is a parish filled with those who believe. May all Catholics have a more vibrant faith and more compelling witness to others of our belief of Jesus, present as Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity in the Eucharist, and share that faith with family and friends in response to the call of the Church. This summer we will have weeks of meditation on John 6, and it will be a time to remind ourselves of the gift that Jesus is to us in the Eucharist. Come, Holy Spirit!

### **Mission Appeal This Weekend**

Each year, we have a “mission appeal” during the summer. This week, we will have the appeal, and I want to encourage us all to give generously to the work of the Church in Uganda. Naomi Corera will be here to talk about the work in her native Uganda, and to ask us to support the Church there. Naomi founded a ministry called “Children Waiting Everywhere,” located in the Diocese of Fort Portal, Uganda. We will take a second collection this weekend, and will add a drop-down option on the online giving portal for donations to be sent to them. Make any checks written to “Resurrection,” with a memo line of either “mission appeal” or “Uganda.” We will make sure that the funds get to them.

In addition to the Mission Appeal this weekend, I am going to invite all parishioners (individuals, not households) to take two or three minutes to complete a survey that will help us discern how best to be of help to you and those you love, as we move forward with our ministry. This is part of the data collection that will help us make the wisest next steps as part of our partnership with *Communio*. The survey will be available until next weekend. (I’ll send emails and text links out, as well.) We are hoping that everyone who regularly attends Mass here will fill this out. Thank you in advance for your input. And please do pray for wisdom as we seek the Lord’s leading in our outreach and formation efforts.

### **Trusting the Lord**

Last weekend, in light of the tragic events in Butler, PA, I encouraged us all (including myself) to take more time praying and meditating on scripture than watching our “timeline” or “news feed.” The temptation to see “what’s new” can be almost irresistible. But the itch for the new post or new video is a temptation that we (whatever our station or age) do well to resist. I myself eliminated (again!) my browser, email, and Twitter/X from my phone, so that it can no longer be the non-stop temptation to “check” what’s new(est) for me. I count myself disciplined, but when events like a week ago occur, I am easily sucked in and mindlessly keep repeating the “refresh.” Not having the apps on my phone makes it easier for me to actually be present with others, and to focus on what the Lord, wishes me to prioritize: loving God and my neighbor. Come, Holy Spirit!

### **President Trump**

I am grateful that the hand of God preserved Donald J. Trump (whom I said definitively at the morning Masses was neither Satan nor Savior) from the assassin’s bullet. Had he died, our nation would have been thrown into unspeakable acrimony and our history would have been forever changed. As it is, our national life has been changed. It seems that the close call has touched the heart of many, including President Trump, and I pray that President Trump and all of us will seek to live lives marked by gratitude and grace. I also hope that all Americans can be less demonizing of others and less triggered by those with whom we may disagree.
