As you know, as Christians, we have a responsibility to vote as members of a representative democracy. Most individuals today are registered when they get a driver's license, but in Michigan, individuals can register as late as on election day. If you aren't registered, or want to verify that you are registered, you can go to this website:

(https://mvic.sos.state.mi.us/Voter/Index) The website allows you to verify that you are registered, tells you where you are supposed to vote, and when and where you can vote early in person. You can order an absentee voting ballot through the website, as well. Please forward this website to your friends and families to ensure that they are registered so they can vote, as well.


