### PLT UPDATE

**WAIT UNTIL 8TH**: At our PLT Open Meeting on Wednesday, October 23rd, the PLT proposed for parents to discern the "Wait Until 8th" program. This is a national organization developed by parents to rally together and delay giving children a smartphone until the end of 8th grade. The intention is to protect children in their elementary and middle school years from the distractions and dangers of a

smartphone. By parenting together in this initiative, parents can establish a unified peer network which decreases the pressure to have a phone at an early age.

While there are other devices to stay connected with one's child, the average age for a child to receive a smartphone is 10 years old. The hope would be for our families in the younger grades to make the commitment before getting smartphones. There will be more discussion on this in the Spring but in the meantime, please check out the program and discern the fit for your family and this community.

#### **MULTI-TIERED SYSTEM OF SUPPORTS**

The MTSS process is used to provide interventions for students who may be struggling in an area of learning. Using standardized test scores (like STAR) and classroom data, the Learning Support Team works with classroom teachers to identify students who may need more intervention.
