Hearing devices are available for use during Mass. Please ask an usher for assistance.

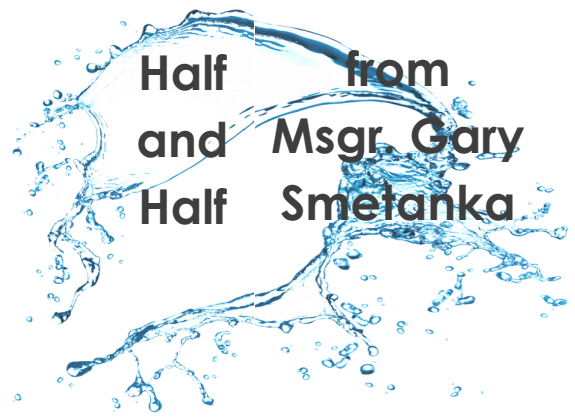

Thanks to all who share the good news of our outstanding elementary and middle school. There was a good buzz, as they say, at the Open House last Sunday. People enjoyed seeing all the artwork the children have been working on as well as the science fair exhibits in the middle school.

I hope you appreciated the short video shown before Mass. Our alumni were very happy to come back and record their testimony regarding the values Star of the Sea School taught them in their lives. I certainly appreciate their enthusiasm to share the good news as well as the talent and time of another alumni, Jill Berndtson who filmed and edited the video testimonies.

We are also very proud and thrilled as to the results of the IOWA standardized test given nationally to **8th graders**. The results are given to show in what academic year, and what month of that year, the students are performing in a subject area. Our 8th graders always do exceptionally well on this national test. This year is no exception!

The results of the IOWA tests show the national average, the average of your "region" or schools similar in a specific area, and then one's specific school. In **science**, the national average is 8.1 (8th grade, first month), our region 10.9 and Star of the Sea 11.5! In **social studies**, nationally 8.0, region 10.0 and Star of the Sea 11.6! In **math**, national average is 8.1, region 9.8 and Star of the Sea 11.3. Finally, in **English**, nationally 7.9, region 10.4 and Star of the Sea 12.9!!!! These results continue to demonstrate what we have known for some time...the longer our students stay with us the higher they achieve! Congratulations to our students, their parents, and our teachers as they partner to achieve these great results.

** At the 9:30 am Mass today (Sunday), our children who are preparing to receive their First Holy Communion participated in their rite of enrollment. On February 2nd, the Church celebrates the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. It is forty days after Christmas and commemorates the act of Mary and Joseph bringing Jesus to the temple as required by Jewish law.

This feast has been called a feast of meeting or encounter. Simeon and Anna were in the temple at that time and their responses upon seeing Jesus can be found in scripture.

Simeon took Him into his arms and praises God saying: "Now, Master, you may let your servant go in peace, according to your word, for my eyes have seen your salvation, which you prepared in the sight of all the peoples: a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and glory for your people Israel." (Luke 2: 29-32)

Anna was a prophetess, "advanced in years...And coming forward at that very time, she gave thanks to God and spoke about the child to all who were awaiting the redemption of Jerusalem". (Luke 2: 36-38)

Two people, two responses. Simeon

praises God and shows his faith that God would send a savior. Anna thanks God and shares the news about the child with others.

Praise, faith, thanksgiving, and sharing. They all can be linked to our efforts to Unleash the Gospel.

Having an attitude of gratitude is important whether we need encouragement or are discouraged. That means praising God continually for who He is and thanking Him for what he has done.

Developing our faith in programs such as bible studies is also encouraged.

Sharing the news is what unleashing the Gospel is all about. The most effective way is through person-to-person encounters.

We all encounter many different people and situations – opportunities to share God’s love, mercy and what He has done for us.
