In emergency situations needing the prompt attention of a priest, please call the parish office.

#### MARRIAGE

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

You don't have to share anything (many Catholics don't like to "share" faith) but can simply walk away with your own thoughts and prayers of thanksgiving! Here is what Fr. 
This year's attendance set yet another record for this very worthy event as Catholic Schools Week is officially launched.
