No one has the right to another person's certificate, except: the parent/guardian of a minor child. (Archdiocese of Detroit)

ANOINTING OF THE SICK/ MINISTRY TO THE SICK

The Church strongly encourages people to receive the Sacrament (Anointing) of the Sick at the early stages of serious sickness or before serious surgeries.

In emergency situations needing the prompt attention of a priest, please call the parish office.

MARRIAGE

Archdiocesan law requires advance notice of at least six months.

PARISH REGISTRATION

Newcomers to the parish may register in the Parish Office during regular office hours. Others, please notify the Parish Office of address changes.

Adults over 21 need to be registered as an individual member to be considered a Catholic in Good Standing.

Hearing devices are available for use during Mass. Please ask an usher for assistance.

We are so thankful to the one who has given us birth and continues to nurture us through life, with all of its bumps, bruises, boasting and burdens. As they say, "once a mother, always a mother!" Let us offer this prayer this day, and live by our prayer, for all living mothers and all that they do.

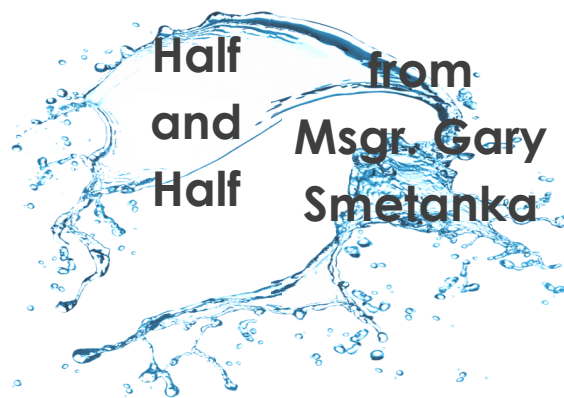

Glory and praise to you, loving God, through Jesus Christ our Lord, who was born of the Virgin Mary, and who reigns with you in the glory of heaven, for ever and ever.

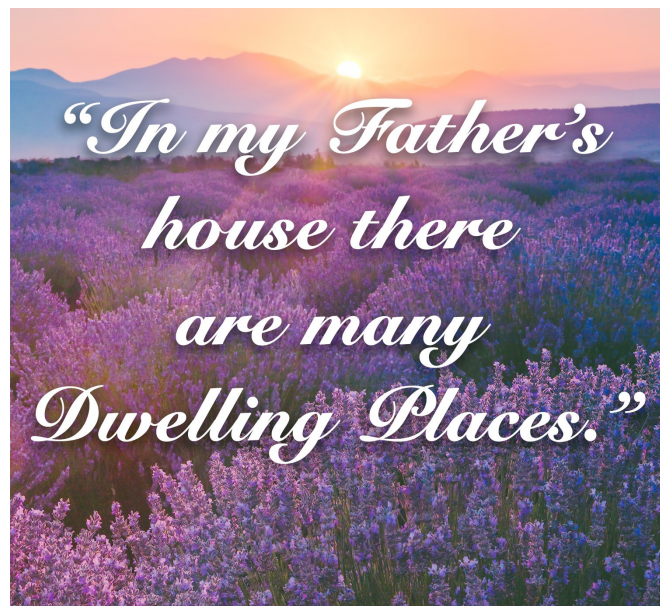
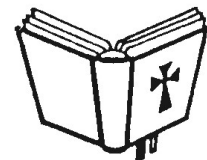
